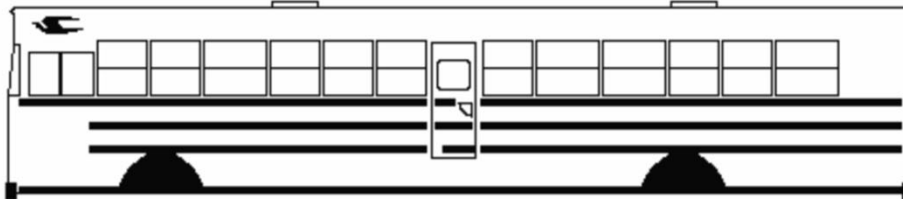

First Day of School Plans:

Culture/Climate:

- Heights' secretaries-**Mayra Mejia** and **Heather Hultberg** decorated the staff room and stocked it full of a candy, caffeine, and goodies for staff as they return for a full day of teaching.
 - Special shout-out to **Don's Donuts** for creating a Stallion Donut and to the **Hultberg Family** for driving to Yakima to pick them up for Heights' staff.
- Miss Mejia and Mrs. Hultberg created a balloon arch for students to walk into as they enter the gym to have their temperature taken/turn in their attestation form.
- Mrs. **Jessie Wilson** will be dressed up as Lightning the Stallion to greet students as they are dropped off.
- Staff and students are encouraged to wear Heights, Mustang, or **red/white** clothing to show school spirit.

Parent Communication:

- Parent communication was sent via robo-dialer, email, website, and social media on 4/9 and 4/12 in regard to opening school back up in a traditional model.

Classroom Expectations for 4/15-17:

- Rosters have changed, teachers have been encouraged to focus on PBIS routines, expectations, and building relationship with new students.

- Room dividers (Maintenance is checking to see if there is any in storage)

Outside the Box Thinking:

- Lunch rotation-half of the students will be eating while the other half will be outside at recess.
- Combine Whitstran and Heights students for the virtual classes.
- Breakfast-We are having to reorganize our attestation/temp. center to accommodate Breakfast after the Bell.

Vaccines:

- I do not know the number of staff who have been vaccinated.
- I do know many have had the opportunity to be vaccinated if they would like to be.

Housel Middle School Full Day Reopening Model:

- All students wishing to return to school will begin attending class in person on April 14th.
- All teachers/staff currently working on site.
- Students remaining remote will receive their instruction simultaneously with students in the classroom.
- Students will move between classes following their regular schedule.
- 500 students scheduled to attend school every day.
- Approximately 114 students will remain remote.
- Full School Day – SWAVID, 6 class periods, lunch and recess.
- 3-foot social distancing required in class, 6-foot social distancing at lunch.

Challenges or modifications as we move from previous model:

- Use of North and South gyms for lunch.
- PE unable to use gyms as classroom space - relocated classes outside on playground or in portables in case of inclement weather.
- Social distancing and classroom capacity limits.
- Required health screenings of 500 students in a limited amount of time before school.
- Monitoring potential COVID exposures and close contact.
- Close contact cases would take approx. 5% of students (25 minimum) out of school for at least 20% of the remainder of the school year.
- Updated policies, procedures, handbooks for new model.
- We are in the process of procuring lunch tables for 150 students in the gym.
- Teacher technology/training to support simultaneous teaching.

Close contact would have to be mitigated. Three feet apart is the stance the district will take.

Campus lunch amended to 60 students per cafeteria at one time. Stands can hold 35 students. Open campus at PHS.

Good weather, won't be a problem. Coverage in the classroom could become an issue. Both gyms get complicated.

Student workers are not allowed, need to keep the clean up contained. Kids can't go through the line. Desks are an issue. Board's desire 5 day a week.

Coleman: Think creatively about lunch. Whatever it takes 5 days a week. Lunch room supervisor volunteer. Frank has all the tables and chairs, tents. Concern that they would get too beat up. Tarp, big courtyards. Tables outside would be great. Checking the forecast and going.

Bryan Bailey-want the kids back in school. Challenges, but we're working through them. A few more students to bring back. Numbers at the high school are a little bit higher. 164 have offered to stay virtual. Would love to provide feedback. ABAB opportunity.

Distancing and cleaning schedules. Be in person.

Do you have a plan if its all students every day? Big question about cohorts or transfer-Amy Person approval. You can run a

normal school day.

Hunt: Do we still need to be AABB? Their recommendation is still AABB? Why can't we do a full day?

Bailey: Can rotate with three foot distancing. Size of the classrooms is the constraint. 3 foot social distancing situation.

CDC/Department of Health guidelines. 701 students that want to return. Rooms too small and different. Some classes in the day- too much overloading. 40 students in one class. Multiple sections during the same periods Everybody back. Wrestling library, mezzanine, etc. Just within an A-L we're packed. Average absences? Attendance is not great-140 students attend for every 175. If/when we come back, attendance will be a major issue. We get the impression that nobody wants to attend in cohorts. If there's a will, there's a way. If we don't follow the three foot social distancing, we can do it. Some solutions to meet the challenges. Will explore all of the spaces.

Douglas: We have to maintain the 3ft distance. Hard as this district and Matt have worked, offended at the way you presented that. Reiterate that we still have to follow the guidelines.

Ellis: Board decides the BFHD medical officers' guidance and CDC. Whatever needs to happen, that is what we have to do. Lack of creative thinking. Classroom bus, creative spaces. Learning spaces. PUD Conference Room. Won't look totally normal.

Coleman: Modeling and do it on the fly. Get him here, figure it out safely. Majority of experts are interested in SEL. Let's get him here, mental health, and sort it out live. Every teacher, administrators need to be engaged and involved. How can we get administrators back right now?

Hunt: Guidance to principals was that in spring, we would monitor the status of CoVid 19, evaluate the model for schooling, continue with allowable activities. Should have been in effect March 11th, not April 7th. We have pushed back and now we want our kids in school. We can make that happen. Spring Break for our kids. Not a normal year. Make sure that we can bring the kids back.

Transportation and food service has done their work.

Paras, interventionists, supports staff, needed custodians. Needed to have happened already.

Subject: Policy Change - Location of Regular Meeting (Policy No. 1400)

1. Current Prosser School District Policy, No. 1400 establishes that the Regular Board Meetings of the Prosser School District will be held at the Prosser High School Library.

a. The current policy regarding location of meeting states, **“Regular meeting are held at 7:00 p.m. on the second and fourth Wednesday of each month in the Prosser High School Library or at other times and places as determined by the presiding officer or by majority vote of the Board.”**

2. Due to changes in school reopening and necessary shifting of classroom space within the district to accommodate the return to school of students within the health and safety guidelines established by the CDC, DOH and the BFHD, the use of the library space at the high school will be needed for classroom instruction for the remainder of the school year. Given this, it is in the school's best interest to maintain that space in a classroom configuration for desks, chairs and spacing. The district has limited resources for custodial and maintenance purposes. Moving the location of our Board meetings will accommodate not having to allocate resources to rearrange that room. It has been recommended that we use the Housel Middle School Library for our regular meeting location until further notice.

3. Based on the needs of the district, space requirements, resource availability and access, I recommend that the Board amended our meeting location. Based on the immediate needs of the district for student space and resources it is recommended that this action proceed for immediate action in accordance the provisions of Policy 1310, Policy Adoption.

a. Policy 1310: Policy Adoption states, “In the event that immediate action on a proposed policy is necessary, the motion for its adoption shall provide that immediate adoption is in the best interest of the district. No further action is required. All new or amended policies shall become effective upon adoption, unless a specific effective date is provided in the motion for adoption.”

4. PROPOSED MOTION:

*“I move that Prosser School District Policy 1400 be amended specifically as follows: Paragraph #2, Regular Meetings shall be amended to read, **“Regular meetings are held at 7:00 p.m. on the second and fourth Wednesday of each month in the Housel Middle School Library or at other times and places as determined by the presiding officer or by majority vote of the Board.”** All other*

provisions of Policy 1400 remain unchanged. Further, in accordance with Policy 1310: Policy Adoption, this motion to change location for regular board meetings is in the best interest of the district and critical to the operational needs of the District. This amendment as proposed shall take effect immediately without further action."

5. Upon passage of the proposed amendment to Policy 1400, the district shall ensure that the policy as amended shall be made part of the minutes of this meeting and shall also be included in the district's policy manual.
