2019-20 General Fund Assumptions

- Enrollment projection (attached) is 2,502 Full-time Equivalent (FTE) students; budgeted enrollment for 2018-19 was 2,547; actual average enrollment was 2,564. Our practice is to project enrollment, then reduce it by 1%.
- K-3 class sizes are funded at 17
- Levy tax rate for calendar years 2019/2020 is reduced from \$3.03 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation to \$1.50
- Includes \$50,000 for summer school
- Beginning Fund Balance is estimated at \$3,300,000

Welcome to a meeting of Prosser School District Board of Directors!

Your views and interest in education are important to us and to your schools. Whether your visit is for the purpose of bringing information to the board's attention, solving a problem, or simply to see what's going on, we hope you'll feel welcome and comfortable at this meeting. We also hope that you will leave with a better understanding of your school district and its board of directors.

How the Board Operates

As the board meeting progresses, you may notice that there is quick action on some items. This is because the board generally considers an issue for several meetings before taking action, and also because background materials on the various items are sent to members for their careful study prior to the meeting. Sometimes the board will approve a motion that encompasses many items. These items, grouped under the "consent" portion of the agenda, are considered routine. You'll be able to follow the action more carefully if you pick up a copy of the agenda that is available.

Board members are: Scotty Hunt, President; Jesalyn Cole, Vice-President; Andy Howe, Peggy S. Douglas and Scott Coleman.

About Board Meetings

Business meetings are held twice each month, usually on the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays. The first meeting of the month is also a time for the various educational programs of the district to provide an educational presentation to the Board. These meetings begin at 7:00 p.m.

The board encourages input on all issues under discussion at the business meetings.

About Executive Sessions

The board may occasionally go into executive session, thus excluding the public and the news media from witnessing the discussion. You should know though, that the board will only discuss issues in executive session. It

must, by law, take all actions in an open meeting. The law also limits what the board can legally discuss in executive session. These closed discussions may only concern litigation, personnel selection or evaluation, negotiations, complaints against an officer or staff member or real estate transactions where public disclosure would be damaging to individuals or the general welfare of the district. Before going into executive session, the board president must estimate the time the board will return to open session.

Study Sessions

Board Study Sessions are held by the board to address specific issues and to give the board an opportunity to have staff make presentations regarding specific areas of instruction or operation. Study sessions are open meetings and offer the community an opportunity to hear the issues being discussed. Study sessions follow the same protocols as regular board meetings for addressing the board with questions or concerns.

Addressing the Board

You may present a concern to the board during the time reserved for hearing public comment. If this is the case we ask that you:

- Prior to the start of the meeting, sign in, noting the topic you intend to address to the board.
- Come to the microphone and state your name.
- Do not reflect adversely on the political or economic view, ethnic background, character or motives of any individual.
- Do keep your comments concise, non-emotional and brief.

The board is interested in hearing your concerns and your compliments too. It's best to call the superintendent's office a couple of days before the meeting. If this isn't possible, you can ask the board president to recognize you during the hearing section.

Board Hearings

The school board can be compared to a

"court of last resort." If a concern cannot be solved by first talking with the teacher, principal, or appropriate district personnel, it may be forwarded to the board for hearing. Sometimes this hearing may be conducted in "executive session," meaning the public and the media are not in attendance.

About Your Board

Public schools are especially close to the communities they serve because they are governed by men and women selected from the community. These men and women - your school board; are volunteers who spend a great deal of time on the many details involved in providing quality education.

Board members serve four-year terms. They are required to file financial disclosure statements with the Washington State Public Disclosure Commission and must be registered voters of the school district

School board members attend meetings, keep communications open with other members of the community and represent the needs of the district before local, state and national representatives. They make critical decisions that have a direct impact on what children learn and how they learn it. However, a school board is a legal body and can only make decisions as a body.

You may notice that many of the decisions the board must make are not directly related to instruction. School board members are also responsible for keeping the buildings and grounds in good shape, balancing the budget, protecting the district's legal interests, and providing for long-range planning.

Approval of Minutes

Minutes from the July 23, 2019 regular Board meeting and the July 31, 2019 special Board meeting were presented.

Contracts and Personal Service Agreements:

1. Amended Memorandum of Agreement with WSU:

Recently the Legislature passed changes to alternative routes to teaching rules that require programs to update their Memoranda of Agreement (MOAs). These changes are largely clarifications to current practices and policies rather than substantial shifts, especially for Route I programs such as the one Prosser School District participates in at WSU Tri-Cities.

2. State Work Study (SWS) Agreement:

As a part of our AVID requirements, we must provide college-age tutors to all of our AVID elective classes at HMS and PHS. The tutorial process is essential for helping students work through challenging courses. This is our fifth year partnering with the State Work Study Program. Under this contract, work study students will continue to be referred through local colleges and universities. As a work study site, our District has 60-70% of the wages covered by the State Work Study program. For our District to consider hiring these students, we must renew our existing contract to continue participating in 2019-2020.

3. Isaac Butts Service Agreement:

Isaac Butts, a youth motivational speaker, will be talking to Prosser High School students on September 6, 2019 during a school assembly on the topic of bullying, focusing on self-value and purpose. Cost for this service is \$2,500.00 and will be funded through the ASB account.

4. Kris Lindeblad Contract

We would like to contract with Kris Lindeblad again. She will provide training beginning in October 2019 with all Prosser High School secondary math teachers. She will work with the staff for approximately 10 days at a rate of \$1,000 a day plus travel expenses from October 2019 through May 2020. Cost of consulting services is \$10,000, plus estimated travel expenses of \$6,000. Funding provided through basic education, curriculum adoption funds.

ACTION ITEMS:

Amendment of Policy No. 2190: Highly Capable Programs – SECOND READING Policy No. 2190: Highly Capable Programs, was brought to the Board at the July 23, 2019 meeting, for First Reading. The policy has a slight revision as of the 2018-19 school year. The new portion is the last sentence in the last paragraph. The update addresses the importance of having processes in place for equitable identification of students, as students who are disadvantaged often are overlooked in the identification process. The policy draft amendment was included in the Board packet as well as the updated procedure.

Motion by Peggy S. Douglas, seconded by Andy Howe and motion carried unanimously to approve the Second and Final Reading of Policy No. 2190: *Highly Capable Programs*, and adopt the policy as amended.

Adoption of Policy No. 3241: Student Discipline - SECOND READING

Policy and Procedure No. 3241: *Student Discipline* was brought to the Board for First Reading at the July 23, 2019, regular Board meeting. The policy addresses student discipline and the way in which it is enacted in classrooms and in schools. The Washington State School Directors' Association (WSSDA) has classified this policy as essential, which means that all districts in Washington must adopt the policy. Much of the policy changes in 3241 seek to keep students in the classroom and mitigate exclusionary measures within schools. Policy No. 3241 is a newly created policy number by WSSDA. They recommend that districts retire the current Policy and Procedure No. 3240: *Student Rules, Regulations and Conduct: Discipline* and replace it with Policy and Procedure No. 3241. The procedure, which was also included in the Board packet, is not finalized but will be prior to implementation.

Motion by Peggy S. Douglas, seconded by Jesalyn Cole and motion carried unanimously to take action to approve the Second and Final Reading of Policy No. 3241: *Student Discipline* for adoption.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

Construction Update

The next elementary construction meeting is scheduled for tomorrow night at 6:30 p.m.

Mr. Ellis reported he had sent the Board a communication regarding soundproofing the recital rooms. He also reported on the land we are asking to regain possession of, which is currently being used by the Crestview Apartments. The owner would like to use some of our water in exchange for giving the land back. Mr. Ellis said there are several different variables which come into play in this complex situation.

Board Meeting August 13, 2019

Deanna Flores reported that PEDA has asked for a tour of the PHS construction site on September 4. She also reported on a gas line situation, which came up at the last construction meeting. The line is very far away from our site and it could cost a lot of money to bring gas to the site. It may or may not be a big issue.

Scott Coleman said that often these situations are resolved without it being a huge expense.

Scotty Hunt asked Mr. Ellis to provide the Board with more information on the parking permits which are now required at PHS. These permits cost \$5.00.

Shawn Schultz explained the process as she understood it.

Safety and Security

Mr. Ellis reported we will be introducing our safety officers at the Kick Off on August 20. They've been training with Jon Ladines this summer. We're planning to revive the safety and security committee. Mr. Ellis also reported that we're going to reinvest some of our security dollars into doing some of our own work.

Mr. Hunt said he'd found good tools on the OSPI website on assessment. He will send the link to the other Board members. This topic will also be on the next Board meeting agenda.

Background

United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) regulations require school districts that participate in the National School Lunch Program, ensure that the average full pay lunch price charged is not less than the difference between the free and paid Federal reimbursement rates. (Free rate is \$3.33; paid rate is \$.33; difference is \$3.00.) This requirement is known as Paid Lunch Equity.

The Federal reimbursement rates are adjusted annually based on the Consumer Price Index. USDA has provided a worksheet that calculates if paid lunch prices need to be increased. This calculation is done annually. For school year 2019-20, the average paid price should be \$3.00. The weighted average paid price by our district for the 2018-19 school year was \$2.90; therefore, we need to increase our paid prices by at least \$.10 (see worksheet attached).

Our recommendation is to raise student paid breakfast, lunch and milk prices by \$.10; adult breakfast and adult lunch by \$.25 for the 2019-2020 school year.

Background

United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) regulations require school districts that participate in the National School Lunch Program, ensure that the average full pay lunch price charged is not less than the difference between the free and paid Federal reimbursement rates. (Free rate is \$3.33; paid rate is \$.33; difference is \$3.00.) This requirement is known as Paid Lunch Equity.

The Federal reimbursement rates are adjusted annually based on the Consumer Price Index. USDA has provided a worksheet that calculates if paid lunch prices need to be increased. This calculation is done annually. For school year 2019-20, the average paid price should be \$3.00. The weighted average paid price by our district for the 2018-19 school year was \$2.90; therefore, we need to increase our paid prices by at least \$.10 (see worksheet attached).

Our recommendation is to raise student paid breakfast, lunch and milk prices by \$.10; adult breakfast and adult lunch by \$.25 for the 2019-2020 school year.

ADOPTION OF 2019-20 BUDGET

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Directors of Prosser Consolidated School District No. 116-219, Benton and Klickitat Counties, Washington, fixing and determining fund appropriations; adopting the 2019-20 budget, the four year budget plan summary and the four-year enrollment projection; approving certain fund transfers; and providing for other related matters.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF PROSSER CONSOLIDATED SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 116-219, BENTON AND KLICKITAT COUNTIES, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Findings and Determinations</u>. The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Prosser Consolidated School District No.116-219, Benton and Klickitat Counties, Washington (the "District"), takes note of the following facts and hereby makes the following findings and determinations:

- (a) Pursuant to RCW 28A.505.040, the District has completed the budget for the 2019-20 fiscal year and published electronic notice of the same on its website. The 2019-20 budget includes, among other things, certain fund transfers, a complete financial plan of the District for the ensuing 2019-20 fiscal year and a summary of the four-year budget plan that includes a four-year enrollment projection.
- (b) Pursuant to RCW 28A.505.060, the Board shall adopt the 2019-20 budget on or before August 31, 2019. Prior to adoption of the 2019-20 budget, the Board shall meet and conduct a public hearing to allow any person to be heard for or against any part of the 2019-20 budget, the four year budget plan, or any proposed changes to uses of enrichment funding under RCW 28A.505.240 (a/k/a maintenance, operations, and educational programs levy).
- (c) The Board, following notice thereof being published in a newspaper of general circulation within the District, conducted a public hearing on August 26, 2019, in accordance with the requirements of RCW 28A.505.060 for the purpose of adopting the 2019-20 budget.
- Section 2. Fixing and Determining Fund Appropriations; Adoption of 2019-2018 Budget. Four-Year Budget Summary and Four-Year Enrollment Projection.
- (a) The Board hereby fixes and determines the appropriation from each fund contained in the 2019-20 budget, as follows:

General Fund	\$ 39,667,670
Capital Projects Fund	\$ 42,450,794
Transportation Vehicle Fund	\$ 282,500
Debt Service Fund	\$ 4,393,598
Associated Student Body Fund	\$ 774,662

(b) The Board hereby adopts the 2019-20 budget, the four-year budget plan summary, and the four-year enrollment projection and the appropriations as fixed and determined above, all of which are on file with the District and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 3. Fund Transfers.

(a) The Board hereby approves and adopts all fund transfers as more particularly described in the 2019-20 budget.

Section 4. <u>General Authorization and Ratification</u>. The Secretary to the Board, the President of the Board, the District's Assistant Superintendent of Business & Operations and other appropriate officers of the District are hereby further authorized to take all other action, to do all other things consistent with this resolution, and to execute all other documents necessary to effectuate the provisions of this resolution, and all actions heretofore taken in furtherance thereof and not inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution are hereby ratified and confirmed in all respects.
