Welcome to a meeting of Prosser School District Board of Directors!

Your views and interest in education are important to us and to your schools. Whether your visit is for the purpose of bringing information to the board's attention, solving a problem, or simply to see what's going on, we hope you'll feel welcome and comfortable at this meeting. We also hope that you will leave with a better understanding of your school district and its board of directors.

How the Board Operates

As the board meeting progresses, you may notice that there is quick action on some items. This is because the board generally considers an issue for several meetings before taking action, and also because background materials on the various items are sent to members for their careful study prior to the meeting. Sometimes the board will approve a motion that encompasses many items. These items, grouped under the "consent" portion of the agenda, are considered routine. You'll be able to follow the action more carefully if you pick up a copy of the agenda that is available.

Board members are: Bill Jenkin, President; Dr. Warren Barmore, Vice-President; Bruce Matsumura, Peggy Douglas and Andy Howe, WIAA representative. Student representatives: Tye Taylor, Taylor Beightol, Zebbie Castilleja & Juan Guerra

About Board Meetings

Business meetings are held twice each month, usually on the 1st and 3rd Tuesdays. The first meeting of the month is also a time for the various educational programs of the district to provide an educational presentation to the Board. These meetings begin at 7:00 p.m.

The board encourages input on all issues under discussion at the business meetings.

About Executive Sessions

The board may occasionally go into executive session, thus excluding the public and the news media from witnessing the discussion. You should know though, that the board will only discuss issues in executive session. It must, by law, take all actions in an open meeting. The law also limits what the board can legally discuss in executive session. These closed discussions may only concern litigation, personnel selection or evaluation, negotiations, complaints against an officer or staff member or real estate transactions where public disclosure would be damaging to individuals or the general welfare of the district. Before going into executive session, the board president must estimate the time the board will return to open session.

Study Sessions

Board Study Sessions are held by the board to address specific issues and to give the board an opportunity to have staff make presentations regarding specific areas of instruction or operation. Study sessions are open meetings and offer the community an opportunity to hear the issues being discussed. Study sessions follow the same protocols as regular board meetings for addressing the board with questions or concerns.

Addressing the Board

You may present a concern to the board during the time reserved for hearing public comment. If this is the case we ask that you:

- Prior to the start of the meeting, sign in, noting the topic you intend to address to the board.
- Come to the microphone and state your name.
- Do not reflect adversely on the political or economic view, ethnic background, character or motives of any individual.
- Do keep your comments concise, nonemotional and brief.

The board is interested in hearing your concerns and your compliments too. It's best to call the superintendent's office a

couple of days before the meeting. If this isn't possible, you can ask the board president to recognize you during the hearing section.

Board Hearings

The school board can be compared to a "court of last resort." If a concern cannot be solved by first talking with the teacher, principal, or appropriate district personnel, it may be forwarded to the board for hearing. Sometimes this hearing may be conducted in "executive session," meaning the public and the media are not in attendance.

About Your Board

Public schools are especially close to the communities they serve because they are governed by men and women selected from the community. These men and women - your school board; are volunteers who spend a great deal of time on the many details involved in providing quality education.

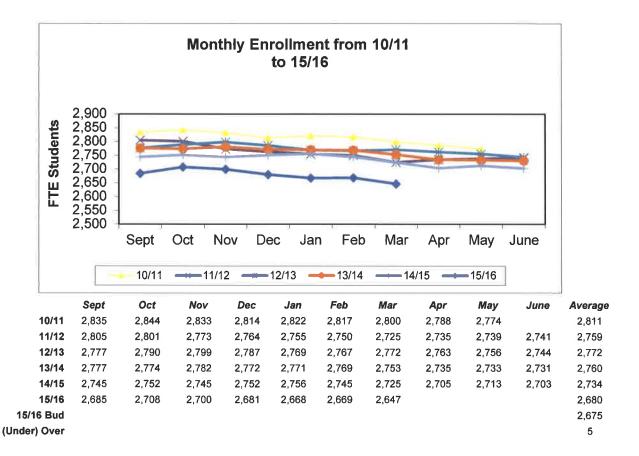
Board members serve four-year terms. They are required to file financial disclosure statements with the Washington State Public Disclosure Commission and must be registered voters of the school district

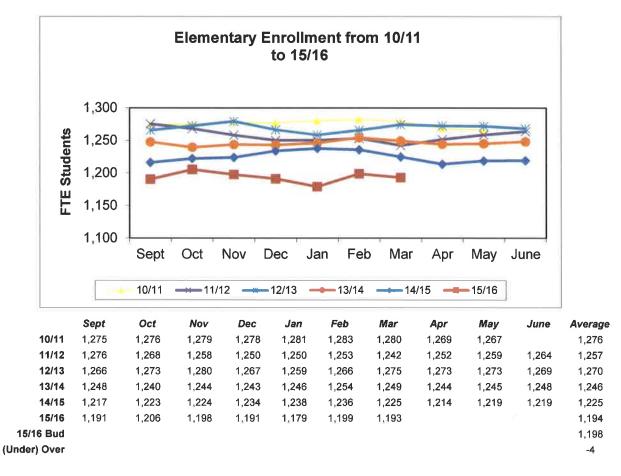
School board members attend meetings, keep communications open with other members of the community and represent the needs of the district before local, state and national representatives. They make critical decisions that have a direct impact on what children learn and how they learn it. However, a school board is a legal body and can only make decisions as a body.

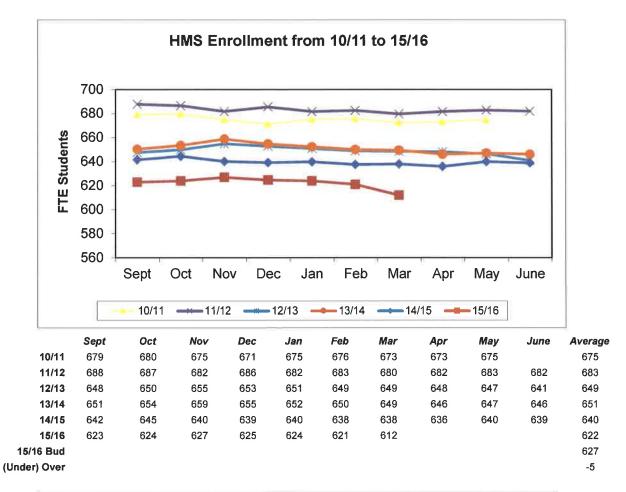

Approval of Minutes

Minutes from the February 16, 2016 regular board meeting and the February 26, 2016 special board meeting were presented.

Contracts and Personal Service Agreements:

1. 2016-2017 Agreement for Achievement Via Individual Determination (AVID) Excel Bilingual Program:

AVID Excel program will be used for bilingual students at middle school level in our district. This program is designed specifically for middle school students who have not exited the bilingual program. It helps to accelerate the acquisition of academic vocabulary. In addition the Excel program supports students to prepare for high school level courses. The goal is to help more students become proficient enough to exit the bilingual program before high school. AVID Excel incorporates teacher trainings and student materials with a cost of approximately \$850. Transitional Bilingual funds will be used to cover the costs of the AVID Excel contract.

2. 2016-2017 Achievement Via Individual Determination (AVID) Agreement: AVID is a college and career readiness system designed to increase the number of students who enroll in college and are prepared for careers. The AVID membership fees allow us to access exceptional online and face to face training for our teachers to support students who struggle to succeed academically. Students are given group and individualized support to achieve success. AVID Weekly, and the site fee total for Prosser High School, Housel Middle School, Heights Elementary, Whitstran Elementary and Keene-Riverview Elementary is \$16,588.00 with funding provided through Title I, Title II and LAP program budgets.

3. Contract for Achievement Via Individual Determination (AVID) Math Summer Bridge Program Agreement:

AVID Math and Science Summer Bridge Program is designed specifically to increase students' math and science knowledge and skills, specifically targeted towards those students who need more support and intervention. It will provide a means for students to have greater access to and success in seventh and eighth grade Algebra I and to enhance students' critical thinking, problem solving skills, and integration of math skills. AVID Math and Science Summer Bridge Program provides student materials with a cost of approximately \$4,900. LAP funding will be used to cover the costs of the AVID Summer Bridge program agreement.

Amendment to Contract:

1. Amend Interlocal Agreement Between Prosser and Grandview School District- Regarding Transportation of Students:

We have an Interlocal Agreement with Grandview School District to transport up to five of their students to Lourdes in Richland. Grandview is requesting to amend the agreement to extend it for the 2015-2016 school year. There is no additional cost to the district to provide this service.

Personal Service Agreements:

1. Tears of Joy Service Agreement:

Tears of Joy will be performing "Jungle Book" at Whitstran Elementary, Prosser Heights Elementary, and a double performance at Keene-Riverview Elementary. This play is performed with the use of hand puppets and encourages performing arts, music, and reading. The cost for the performance at Whitstran Elementary is \$700; \$750 at Heights and \$900 at Keene-Riverview. Each building will pay for the performances out of their ASB Fund.

2. Buck & Elizabeth Service Agreement:

Buck & Elizabeth are singers/ songwriters that provide creative writing projects for 1st grade students. Buck & Elizabeth will provide 4 song writing workshops, 4 recordings, school assembly for all students, an evening performance at Housel Middle School, and 25 CDs to all 1st grade teachers. This project will take place March 7-10, 2016 with a total cost of \$1,700.

3. Whitney Appelgate-Picture This Photography Service Agreement: Whitney Appelgate from Picture This Photography will be taking pictures during Prosser High School Prom. There is no fee for this service; students may purchase their own photographs.

4. Missoula Children's Theatre (MCT):

MCT is performing Rapunzel May 13 and May 14 at the Princess Theatre. PSD students grades K-8 are given the opportunity to try out and perform in the play. The fee for rehearsal, performance, and workshops is \$2,900 with a deposit of \$500. Fees will be paid out of Missoula Children's Theatre Budget.

For the 2016/17 school year, PHS plans to begin scrimmaging other local clubs along with potential involvement in the Spring WIAA Speech and Debate Competition.

By the 2017/18 school year, the Speech and Debate team hopes for full participation and competitions sponsored by both regional teams and state association. Mrs. Gwen Pennington has provided the leadership and supervision of the students who have shown interest in the program.

Taylor Beightol, Kennia Martinez, Jay Munn and Miguel Orr presented a Power Point slide presentation on the Speech and Debate Club, different type of competitions, how it was created, the cost of having this club at PHS, the timeline of activities, fundraising ideas and benefits to the community. After the presentation, the students answered several questions from the board members.

Dr. Tolcacher said the District will help fund this club.

Motion by Warren Barmore, seconded by Andy Howe and motion carried to approve the PHS Speech and Debate team to be a recognized PHS club.

<u>Application Hosting Agreement with ESD 105 for SafePointe Application</u> As the District moves ahead with the SafePointe application installation with 4Qtrs Holdings at Housel Middle School and Prosser High School, ESD 105 will provide on-site hosting services for users of this application. ESD 105 will provide safe, secure and reliable hosting, daily system checks, system updates and user management under this agreement. This eliminates the need to manage and monitor these needs from within the District.

Payment to ESD 105 for hosting services is equal to \$2.10 per full-time equivalent student at Housel Middle School and Prosser High School based on totals from the school year ending 2015:

Housel Middle School – 623 Prosser High School – 884

Payment for the hosting services will come out of the technology software budget.

Motion by Andy Howe, seconded by Warren Barmore and motion carried to approve the application hosting agreement with Educational Service District 105.

Out-of-State Travel: Summer Training for Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID)

AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination) is a college and career readiness system designed to increase the number of students who enroll in college and are prepared for careers. Although AVID serves all students, it focuses on the least served students in the academic middle. AVID raises expectations for students and puts in place a support system to help them rise to the challenge. Students are given group and individualized support to achieve success. Each year the Board of Directors has approved an AVID contract that provides staff from Housel Middle School and Prosser High School to receive AVID training. As part of that original contract, the District committed to the continuation of training and ongoing implementation of the program.

Prosser School District started hosting AVID Path Training two years ago where the bulk of our AVID training takes place. However, there are several training options that are not offered. This is why we will be sending staff from Housel Middle School and Prosser High School to AVID Summer Institute, which requires out-of-state travel approval. The training will be held in San Diego, California from June 21 – June 23, 2016 and August 1 – August 3, 2016. The cost of this training will be funded by the following: Title I, II and III. This expense has already been approved in the 2015/2016 budget. This request is for approval of out-of-state travel only.

Motion by Warren Barmore, seconded by Andy Howe and motion carried to approve the outof-state travel for AVID training.

Dr. Tolcacher asked Shellie Hatch to address the board, as she has been accepted as an AVID staff developer. Shellie said she will be bringing an item to the Board, to approve out-of-state travel, for her to continue her training. Shellie said AVID pays for everything. Mabton School District is coming over in a week and a half to visit KRV and Whitstran.

Concordia University will provide a coordinator to work with the student teacher and the District. Requests for placements will be made through the Assistant Superintendent. The agreement specifies responsibilities of the university and the District.

Recommendation:

Approval of the agreement with Concordia University, Portland, Oregon for student teacher placements is recommended.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made and entered into by and between:

Concordia University, Portland, Oregon (hereinafter "University") and

Prosser School District #116, Prosser, Washington (hereinafter "District")

for the purpose of providing cooperative arrangements for the placement of University Students with the District working with the following:

Classroom Teacher and/or School Administrator

In consideration of the promises and conditions contained herein, the District and the University do mutually agree as follows:

I. The District has the responsibility to:

- A. Provide a mentor teacher or administrator, staff, and facilities for the supervision of University students participating in a clinical experience placement with the District. The student teaching or practicum mentors will have had at least two years of successful experience in the roles in which the mentors will supervise.
- B. Provide the University with District policies, regulations, and procedures relative to the student experience.
- C. Reserve the right to interview and approve students proposed for placement with the District, consistent with District and University policy of non-discrimination with regard to race, color, national origin, age, creed, sex, and disability.
- D. Announce the availability of in-service education programs and to encourage participation of students in these programs.
- E. Verify that each University student participated in the number of hours required by the University.
- F. Provide an evaluation of each student's performance at the end of each semester of placement.
- G. Have access to or acquire University information, including confidential candidate information on a need-to-know basis only. Therefore, the District and its representatives will not disclose this information except with prior written permission or specific exceptions set forth in the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, 34 CFR Part 99, nor use this information in any other capacity other than set forth in this agreement.

II. The University has a responsibility to:

- A. Assist the District in assessing the training needs of students.
- B. Provide sufficient copies of the course outline, including general objectives, evaluative materials, and University handbooks for distribution to all cooperating teachers and principals hosting University students.
- C. Nominate students for placement with the District, consistent with District and University policy of non-discrimination with regard to race, color, national origin, age, creed, sex, and disability.
- D. Make the final determination regarding the student's success in any clinical experience.
- E. Provide pertinent personal and academic information to the student's mentor.
- F. Ensure University personnel and University students abide by the policies, regulations, and procedures currently or hereafter adopted by the District.
- G. Provide liability insurance with limits of not less than \$1,000,000/\$3,000,000 for personal injury and \$100,000 for property damage covering the activities of the University and its students.
- H. Ensure that University students have satisfactorily completed any health screening required by the District.
- I. Provide affiliation dates and number of students participating.
- J. Provide the District with information concerning the results of University student evaluations of their experiences with the District.
- K. Require all students to successfully complete a national fingerprint background check and to verify the results to the District, prior to placement with the District. During the term of agreement, students of the University will have contact with public school children. Therefore, the University is prohibited from placing with the District any student who has plead guilty or has been convicted of any felony crime involving the physical neglect, injury, death, sexual abuse, or exploitation of a minor.
- L. Have access to or acquire District information, including confidential student information on a need-to-know basis only. Therefore, the University and its students will not disclose this information except with prior written parental permission or specific exceptions set forth in the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, 34 CFR Part 99, nor use this information in any other capacity other than set forth in this agreement.

III. IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED THAT:

- A. All requests for assignments of students to a position will be made by the University to the District's designee. The District's designee will determine the number of students that can be accommodated by the District and may have to refuse the University's request if positions are not available.
- B. The District's designee will make assignments of students to District personnel. In no case will University students make arrangements directly with District and/or building personnel.
- C. In assigning students, each party recognizes that it may be desirable for students to work with more than one District cooperating teacher or mentor. The District, to the extent possible, will facilitate such arrangements.
- D. Each party shall inform the other of changes in supervision, coordination, and expectations regarding the student placement experience.
- E. Representatives of the University and District shall meet as needed to plan, evaluate, and modify the student program.
- F. Either the University or the District may discontinue the placement of a student following consultation between representatives of each institution.
- G. The candidates assigned to placements by the University are in attendance at the District solely to complete their education programs at Concordia University.
- H. The District, its employees and agents, are acting in an independent capacity in the performance of this agreement and not as officers, employees, or agents of the University.
- I. There shall be no financial obligations between the District and the University except as provided below:
 - $\sqrt{}$ stipend (see attached Appendix A)
 - $\sqrt{}$ other (see attached Appendix Å)
- J. The University agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the District, its officers, agents, and employees from any and all claims and losses resulting from the University's or its students' performance of this agreement.
- K. The District agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the University from any and all claims and losses resulting from the District's performance of this agreement.
- L. This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes any other written or oral agreements between them regarding the same subject matter; it may not be modified except by mutual written agreement of the parties, and may not

be assigned without the written consent of all parties. No delay or failure of either party to exercise any specific rights or responsibilities contained here shall constitute a waiver of any of the other rights listed.

- M. This agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Washington.
- N. The term of this agreement shall begin on March 9, 2016 and will remain valid in effect until modified by mutual agreement or terminated. Subsequent agreements may be entered into by the mutual written agreement of the parties. This agreement may be terminated at any time by the mutual written agreement of the parties. Either party may terminate this agreement upon thirty (30) days advance written notice to the other party. Such notice shall be deemed given when placed in the U.S. mail, registered or certified, return receipt requested, or delivered in person to the other party's representative.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT APPENDIX A

The University agrees to provide the following services or benefits to the District participants in exchange for District services provided under the agreement:

A. **STIPENDS**

1. Mentoring stipends and benefits extended directly to the cooperating teacher and mentor are to be considered a token of recognition for services rendered to the teaching and education profession. In accepting a student teacher or clinical experience candidate, the cooperating mentor agrees to accept also the stipend and benefits established by the University. The stipend shall be as follows for each candidate supervised:

Student Teaching Cooperating Teacher	\$225.00
Practicum Cooperating Teacher	\$170.00
Field Experience Cooperating Teacher (45 hours)	\$ 70.00
Field Experience Cooperating Teacher (90 hours)	\$ 80.00
Administrative Practicum Mentor Administrator (preferred)	\$185.00
Administrative Practicum Mentor Administrator (supplemental)	\$130.00
District Level Practicum Administrator	\$210.00

If a candidate should leave the clinical experience assignment for any reason after he/she has actually been in the classroom or assigned school, the stipend and benefits are still to be issued to the cooperating teacher or mentor.

2. The University shall pay the stipend to cooperating teachers and mentors at the end of the semester. These stipends will be paid directly to the school district to be passed along to the cooperating teacher in accordance to Oregon Ethics Laws for public employees and in accordance to district policy.

B. OTHER BENEFITS TO COOPERATING TEACHERS AND MENTORS WHO SUPERVISE CLINICAL EXPERIENCE CANDIDATES

Cooperating teachers and mentors who supervise a practicum or student teaching candidate will receive a tuition voucher that provides complimentary coursework at Concordia University in Portland, Oregon. The voucher may be redeemed for either three (3) undergraduate credits or (1) graduate credit. Vouchers must be redeemed within three (3) semesters from the conclusion of the mentoring experience. Vouchers may not be combined. No more than three (3) complimentary undergraduate credits or one (1) complimentary graduate credit may be redeemed per semester. There are three semesters at Concordia University: fall, spring and summer. Vouchers are non-transferrable. If the cooperating teacher or mentor enrolling desires residence services, health services, or other incidental student services, the cooperating teacher or mentor shall pay the fees applicable based on the student carrying load.
