The elves are hard at work making toys before their deadline. Wear a Santa or elf hat!

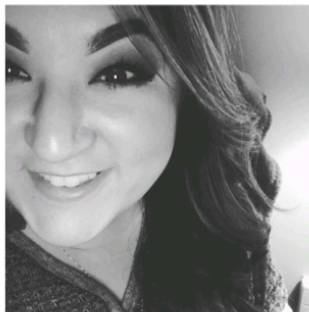
Thursday, December 16: Think Win-Win
