"We encourage schools and communities to take time Feb. 15 to let their SROs know how much they appreciate the work these officers do to bridge gaps between law enforcement and youth and to keep schools safe."

# Upcoming Digital Safety Event for Trinity families with 3rd graders and up.

The Lafayette County School Districts of Concordia, St. Paul, Santa Fe, Trinity, & Wellington/Napoleon have recently collaborated with School Resource Officers (Deputy Beckfield and Depty Newman) to create a Youth Safety Team. The creation of this collaborative stemmed from a professional development opportunity that allowed stakeholders to view a documentary entitled *Childhood 2.0.* After viewing, a discussion began regarding how to include our communities in this important safety initiative.

As a result, on March 9, Santa Fe and Trinity will host a community viewing of the *Childhood 2.0* documentary at Santa Fe High School. Dinner will be served at 5:30 p.m. with the film beginning promptly at 6:00 p.m. Childcare will be provided by licensed daycare staff for children under the age of viewing (12 and under).

After the completion of the film, Santa Fe students will lead roundtable discussions to gather your valuable feedback and to achieve the goals of this event:

- Educate our community about the opportunities, challenges, and dangers of digital citizenship and digital safety
- Educate students and parents to properly utilize technology, while empowering them by providing tools that will allow both to be proactive in protection and safety
- Assist those parenting in the technological world by teaching parents and guardians to navigate the ever-changing landscape of raising children in the digital age

Prior to the community event on March 9, all Santa Fe students in grades 7-12 will have the opportunity to view *Childhood 2.0* at school under the supervision of administration, counselors, and faculty. Students will then have the opportunity to become part of the leadership group that will host the community event on March 9.

Santa Fe & Trinity Lutheran Schools encourage ALL parents, community members, and those who work closely with youth to attend the screening of this important documentary.
