† To our gracious congregation & community; we are so thankful for your continued support, love, and prayers for the school.

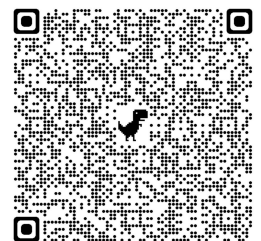
NO SCHOOL NEXT WEEK (preschool - 8th grade)
