COVID-19 Test Kit Distribution Consent and Waiver

The Huron County Health Department, through the Ohio Department of Health, is making COVID-19 Test Kits available to school districts throughout Ohio for distribution. The South Central School District Board of Education has received an allocation of Test Kits, and will be distributing them to staff and students, following receipt of consent and signed waiver in the following priority order: quarantined staff, quarantine student-athletes, quarantined students in extracurricular competition/events/concerts.

Distribution and receipt of a Test Kit are totally voluntary. By accepting a Test Kit, the Participant, and Parent/Guardian, as applicable, agree and understand that the South Central School District is not involved in the manufacture, processing, or analyzing of the Test Kit or results, and is not rendering any medical care or opinion related to the distribution of the Test Kit. While precautions will be taken for the safety of staff students, the Participant, and Parent/Guardian, if applicable, understand(s) that the South Central School District, its Board, officials, employees, and volunteers are not liable for any injury, damage, result or error, which may occur to the Participant as a result of receiving the Test Kit.
