Job Descriptions for Bus Driver

Official Supervisor

Superintendent or Director of Transportation

Job Summary

A bus driver provides safe and efficient transportation so that students may enjoy the fullest possible advantage of the district's curricular and co-curricular programs.

Qualifications

High school diploma, or equivalent, preferred Current, properly classified school bus driver's license

Skills

Operates a school bus safely and efficiently Communicates effectively with students and parents Maintains student discipline on a school bus

Length of Employment

180 days per year; runs/routes per day as determined by supervisor or director of transportation.

Evaluation

By superintendent or transportation director, based on "Job Functions"

Job Functions

- A. Punctuality
 - 1. Performs duties and assignments in a punctual fashion according to the given schedule
 - 2. Adheres to established laws, policies, rules, regulations, and collective bargaining agreements regarding punctuality
 - 3. Submits time sheets and other required paperwork in a timely manner
- B. Safe driving performance
 - 1. Provides safe transportation to and from school and school activities.
 - 2. Observes all safety regulations and keeps the safety and well-being of students as top priority
 - 3. Obeys all traffic laws and maintains a safe driving record
 - 4. Has knowledge of students' medical concerns and medical plans of action
- C. Monitoring Bus/Vehicle Conditions
 - 1. Checks condition of the bus/vehicle before a trip

- 2. Reports standard maintenance needs and mechanical failures to the transportation director
- 3. Keeps bus/vehicle clean and properly fueled

D. General Procedures

- 1. Transports only authorized students
- 2. Discharges students only at authorized stops
- 3. Maintains discipline and reports any discipline problems to the appropriate administrator
- 4. Enforces established bus rules (e.g. the bringing of food and beverages aboard) consistently
- 5. Applies "Job Functions" while driving out-of-district school trips
- 6. Attends all in-service meetings on selected topics
- 7. Is acquainted with all new rulings and laws governing pupil transportation as they relate to the bus driver
- 8. Immediately reports all bus accidents (no matter how minor), traffic violations, and citations to the superintendent of transportation director

E. Communication and Cooperation

- 1. Communicates and cooperates with all levels of school staff, students, and parents regarding the transportation of students
- 2. Uses sound judgment when dealing with students on the bus
- 3. Is a positive role model for students, has a neat appearance, and uses proper language near students
- 4. Demonstrates interest, enthusiasm, and a positive attitude toward work
