

WCHS eLearning on January 10th

Hello Parents, Guardians, and Students,

On January 10th, 2022, WCHS will commence the start of the 2nd Semester with an eLearning day. The first eLearning assignment of the year will be based off of each student's Enrichment period and will not come from individual teachers. This will help the transition of students entering new classes and have yet to meet their new teachers.

Students can find their assignments (experiences) in the Bingo board below. Just like a game of Bingo, we are asking students to complete a line of tasks aligned with the 4 Pillars of the Warsaw Community Schools strategic plan; Empathy, Inclusivity, Experience, and Adaptability. Vertical, horizontal and diagonal are all acceptable. Try and complete at least 3 of 4 activities. However, for those looking for a real challenge, try and get as many as possible.

We encourage students to choose activities that will support their academic goals and/or enrich the lives of others. Student experiences will be shared in Enrichment on Thursday, January 13th, 2022.

Who should complete the January 10th eLearning assignments below?

Will school be open on January 10th, 2022?

School will be virtual on January 10th, 2022. Students can contact their teachers if needed but no eLearning assignments will be given by individual teachers.

What assignment should my student be working on?

We are asking all students of WCHS to complete at least 3 of the assignments below. These experiences will be shared during their first Enrichment class.

How will students submit their assignments?

On January 13th students will complete a Google form during their enrichment period.

What is the Enrichment class?

All students at WCHS have a period each week dedicated to enriching their lives and the lives of others through a variety of activities and events. Students will often remain with their same Enrichment teacher for the entirety of their high school career and be able to have a trustworthy adult who can help them reach their goals in life.
