## **CIPA COMPLIANCE**

Schools must comply with federal laws such as the Child Internet Protection Act which requires that K-12 schools and libraries in the United States use Internet filters and implement other measures to protect children from harmful online content as a condition for federal funding.



## **ACTIVITY FLAGGING**

Helps PCHS detect potentially dangerous activity such as self-harm or bullying. Specific phrases are flagged that may lead to acts of violence upon oneself or others, the purchase of narcotics/weapons and cyber bullying. These flags will be reported to PCHS administration.



## **ONLINE MONITORING**

Using Google's Admin Console and Chrome OS, GoGuardian is able to offer its complete Chromebook filtering and monitoring software wherever the device may be.



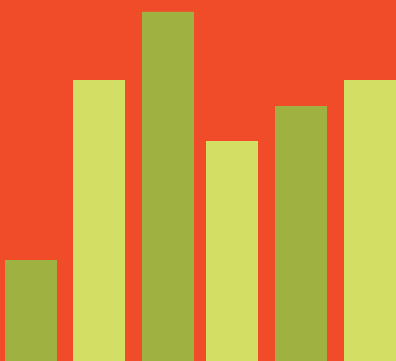
## **THEFT RECOVERY**

Anti-Theft mode disables the Chromebooks. School officials can track down a stolen Chromebook with geolocation information along with login activity.
