### **VACCINATION UPDATES**

Please follow the directions below to guide the updating of your child's records:

Step One: Log onto Genesis.

Step Two: Go to the Forms section and locate the COVID-

19 Vaccination Status form.

**Step Three**: Fill out the question with the red asterisk. Next, if your child is fully vaccinated, upload a picture of the card.

Step Four: Click "Update Answers."

Note: If your child is not fully vaccinated, you may update the form if/when their status changes.

# PICKING UP YOUR CHILD FOR AN EARLY DISMISSAL? WE NEED YOUR HELP!

As per the MHS Parent-Student Handbook, please adhere to the following:

All early dismissal notes should be turned into the Main Office at least one day prior to the date you are requesting to be excused. Be certain to include your telephone number on your note. Early dismissals will only be approved by the office for reasons that are legitimate. If (because of an unforeseen development) a student needs an early dismissal but was unable to submit a note one day in advance, parents are expected to call the Main Office to make necessary arrangements prior to picking up their child at school.

In order for the office staff to assist with early dismissals, the office staff will send the student a written pass so that the student may leave class at the requested time. By giving the students a pass, it allows us from interrupting the classroom and disrupting content instruction.

# QUARANTINE INSTRUCTION & TRAVELING INFORMATION

Metuchen School District's Plan delineates when a student would be excluded from the school. Students are excluded if they are:

- COVID positive;
- Sick with multiple COVID symptoms (worse than baseline for chronic conditions – consult with school nurse):
- An unvaccinated close contact; or,
- Unvaccinated and have traveled out-of-thetristate-area, per CDC guidelines.

A remote learning option is **only available** for students who are quarantined by the district. If unvaccinated, a student may be excluded upon their return and then qualify for Quarantine Instruction. Please review the district's <u>Quarantine Instruction</u> <u>Plan 2021-22</u> for more information on how instruction is established under these circumstances.
