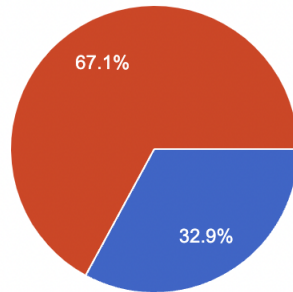

Regarding masks in the schools.



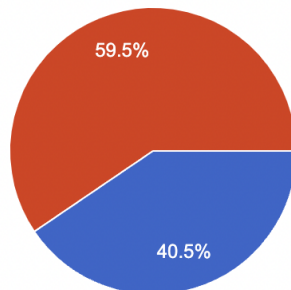
