The Seminole County Board of Education met on October 18, 2021. The following members were present: Mr. William L. Robinson, Dr. Charles O. - I. Chairman Dr. Charles Walker called the meeting to order.
- II. William L. Robinson gave the invocation.
- III. Chairman Dr. Charles Walker established a quorum with four members present.
- IV. Mr. Paul Fryer, Field Representative for Sanford Bishop, introduced himself to the Seminole County Board of Education and its meeting attendees.
- V. William L. Robinson made a motion with a second from Dr. Michael Kirkland to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.
- VI. Vice-Chairman Spencer Stewart made a motion with a second from Dr. Michael Kirkland to approve the minutes from the regularly scheduled board meeting on September 13, 2021. Motion carried unanimously.
- VII. William L. Robinson made a motion with a second from Dr. Michael Kirkland to approve the September 2021 financial statement. Motion carried unanimously.

 - PaddyNet MOU Medicaid Reimbursements

Dr. Michael Kirkland made a motion with a second from Vice-Chairman Spencer

Stewart to approve the Memorandum of Agreement between Medical Provider Services, Inc. (PaddyNet) and the Seminole County School System. Motion carried unanimously.

Millage Rate

William L. Robinson made a motion with a second from Vice-Chairman Spencer Stewart to approve and accept the rollback for the Seminole County Board of Education from 16.0370 to 15.9450 and the rollback for the Seminole County Public Library from .761 to .758. Motion carried unanimously.

• Title I and V Budgets

Dr. Michael Kirkland made a motion with a second from William L. Robinson to approve the Title IA Budget – Improving Academic Achievement and the Title V Budget – Rural and Low Income Schools for the 2021-2022 school year. Motion carried unanimously.

Walk Behind Reel Mower

Vice-Chairman Spencer Stewart made a motion with a second from Dr. Michael Kirkland to approve the purchase of a John Deere 260 SL Walk Behind Mower for the Seminole County School System for \$4,850 to help maintain all athletic fields. Motion carried unanimously.

Professional Learning for BOE Members

Superintendent Mark Earnest gave the board members a handout containing the details of their required nine hours of professional learning. The Georgia Leadership Associates, as well as the school principals and Mrs. Felicia Purdy, will be conducting the sessions and updates for the board members.

Superintendent Mark Earnest reminded everyone that early voting started on October 12 and that citizens will be able to vote on Saturday, October 23.

Meeting with Southern Regional Technical College

Superintendent Mark Earnest gave the board members an update of the meeting that was held between himself, Shane Purdy, Principal of Seminole County Middle/High School, Mary Jean Albritton, CTAE Director and Southern Regional Technical College on September 20.

Fall Bootstrap

Superintendent Mark Earnest will be at Fall Bootstrap on October 19 - 21, 2021 in Athens, GA.

CTAE GOSA Rural Education Grant

Mary Jean Albritton, CTAE Director, received the CTAE GOSA Rural Education grant for \$100,000. This money will go towards new equipment for the CTAE Program.

• Computer Science Resource Grant

Mrs. Felicia Purdy and Mrs. Gina Newberry received a Computer Science Resource grant for \$9,067 for her classroom at Seminole County Elementary.

Technology Grant

Mr. Glen Arnold, Technology Director, received a technology grant of \$227,000 that will help with the purchasing of more student Chromebooks and technology for the classroom.
