

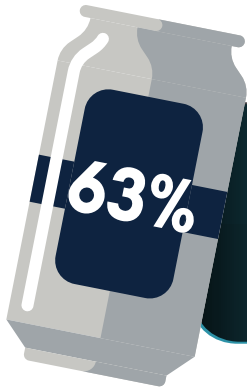

63% have never drank alcohol.

81.4% have never tried cigarette smoking.

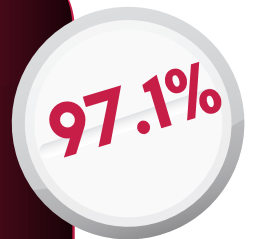


Have Never Tried Marijuana

77.2% have never used marijuana.

Have Never Tried Rx Drugs

97.1% have never tried a prescription drug such as Ritalin, Adderall, or Xanax without a doctor's prescription during the past 30 days.

Who Was Surveyed?

HS Students

92.2% **HAVE NOT** binge drank in the past 30 days.



In the 2018 survey, 88.6% had not binge drank.

Drinking at Another Home

60%

60% of HS students said they drank alcohol at another person's home in the past 30 days. Parents are Prevention. Help curb underage drinking by not hosting.



HS Students

63% **HAVE NEVER** drank alcohol.



In the 2018 survey, 54.3% have never drank alcohol.

HS Students

79.9% **HAVE NEVER** been drunk.



In the 2018 survey, 73.7% have never been drunk.



■ Clinton 79.6% ■ Ovid-Elsie 79.9%

Ovid-Elsie HS **ranks slightly higher** than Clinton County teens on never having been drunk.

HS Students

81.4% **HAVE NEVER** tried cigarette smoking.

+ In the 2018 survey, 76.8% never tried cigarette smoking.



80% HS Students 80.4% **HAVE NOT** used an electronic vapor product in the past 30 days.

+ In the 2018 survey, 74.2% didn't use an electronic vapor product in the past 30 days.



13.5 Years Old

13 1/2 years old is the **AVERAGE** of a teen's first tobacco use.



The Good News? 97.6% of students reported their parents felt cigarette use to be wrong or very wrong.

■ Clinton 83.3% ■ Ovid-Elsie 81.4%

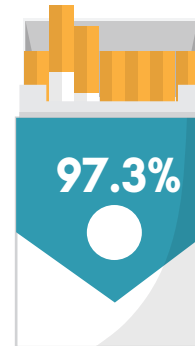
Ovid-Elsie HS **ranks lower** than Clinton County teens on never having tried cigarette smoking.



Borrowing Vapes 43.9%

Almost half the HS students who vaped in the past 30 days, borrowed their vaping product.

Vaping is not harmless. Vaping nicotine can alter teen brain development and lead to a nicotine addiction.



HS Students 97.3% **HAVE NOT** smoked cigarettes in the past 30 days.



In the 2018 survey, 95% didn't smoke cigarettes in the past 30 days.

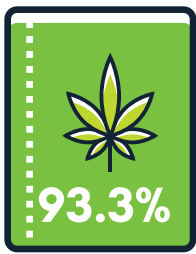
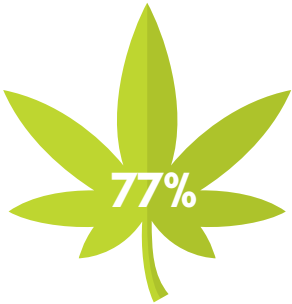
HS Students

93.3% **HAVE NEVER** used synthetic marijuana.

Clinton 92.1% Ovid-Elsie 93.3%

Ovid-Elsie HS **ranks higher** than Clinton County teens for not using synthetic marijuana.



Marijuana is detrimental to a developing teen's brain.



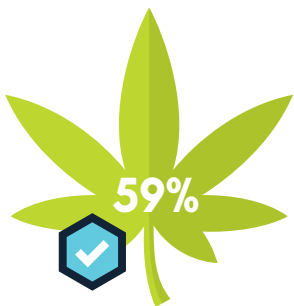
86.1% **HS Students**
