Primary Purpose:

Duties:

- 1. Provide cultural guidance to students; to conduct and/or facilitate Lakota spiritual ceremonies, oral traditions, cultural studies, and to do other related work.
- 2. Works with students on spiritual matters, cultural perspective; conducts and facilitates lessons including but not limited to drum, tobacco, and revitalization ceremonies.
- 3. Organizes and provides instruction to activities in Lakota spiritual expressions, oral traditions, ethics, cultural heritage, and music; cooperates with other staff members in carrying out the mission of Isna Wica Owayawa/Loneman School.
- 4. Supervise the arranging of programs to visit spiritual and cultural sites.
- 5. Adhere to Isna Wica Owayawa/Loneman School policies and procedures.
- 6. Perform other duties as assigned.

Requirements:

- > Knowledge of Native American culture and language preferred.
- Must possess/obtain and maintain a legal driver's license.
- Must take and pass a Drug & Alcohol test, background check and fingerprinting.
- ➤ Will participate in Isna Wica Owayawa/Loneman School activities that include the community.

Qualifications:

- A. High School Diploma is required.
- B. Must have an A.A. degree or higher in Education, Lakota Culture or other related field of study or have good experience teaching or leading cultural activities with groups.
- C. Must have knowledge of the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation, its history, tribal law, philosophy and language.
- D. Ability to organize, prepare and conduct a variety of cultural lessons and activities.
