INFORMATION:

The Alliance Kiwanis Memorial Fund was established to provide annual scholarships to local graduating high school seniors. The Fund is accepting applications for its 42nd Annual Awards. The fund was established by the families of the late Dr. Thomas Auld and the late Mr. Frank Peters. The growth of the fund is assured by contributions made from time to time in memory of other deceased Kiwanians, and includes income from investment earnings. Generally, the amount of the awards will be based upon the income earned by the fund during the previous fiscal year. This year we will be awarding six (6) \$1,000 scholarships.

The selection of the annual recipients will be made by the Alliance Kiwanis Scholarship Committee.

The students selected will be announced at the Senior Awards Program of their respective schools. Actual disbursement of the money will be made upon formal enrollment in a recognized institution offering a post-high school curriculum. Money will be awarded in the form of a check given at a regular Kiwanis Club meeting after the Senior Awards programs.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. The applicant must be a high school senior **with an Alliance home mailing address**. This includes seniors from Alliance High School, as well as qualifying seniors from Marlinton, St. Thomas Aquinas, and West Branch High Schools.

2. The award must be used to further the students' post-high school education at a recognized institution offering a post-high school curriculum, such as college or university, technical school, or specialty training school.

3. Scholarship Achievement, Leadership Abilities, Extracurricular Activities, and Community Service shall be considered in selecting the recipient of the award. Financial need is not a consideration for the Kiwanis Scholarship.

4. There shall be no discrimination in the selection of the recipient based on gender, race, or religion.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Each applicant should pay close attention to the following instructions:

1. PLEASE give detailed and explicit answers to all items in the student application form. Requested items that are omitted will result in your application being disqualified.

2. Turn in completed application forms to the guidance counselor designated by your school for delivery to the Alliance Kiwanis Club via email: patty@alliance-equipment.com

3. **IMPORTANT**...Attach two recommendations from teachers, and one by a minister or employer (or other adult outside of the family who is acquainted with you through a non-school activity). These recommendations must be included in the completed application packet.

4. Completed applications must be received by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 25, 2022. Your application will be due in the guidance office **BEFORE** that time so that your counselor has time to collect and deliver all applications by the deadline.

5. **Any applications received after this date and time will not be considered.**

6. **Incomplete applications will not be accepted.**
