


Arrival and Dismissal Guidelines

<u>Arrival and Dismissal Locations According to Youngest Child in Family</u> If your youngest child is in:

- Kindergarten/1st Grade Yellow 3rd Street (heading west towards Broadway St.)
 - Approach from the <u>east</u> on 3rd Street in the <u>right lane</u>. After drop off/pick up proceed west on 3rd St. You will not be able to turn right onto Louisiana Street.
- 2nd/3rd Grade Green Louisiana Street
 - Approach from the <u>south</u> on Louisiana Street. <u>You will not be able to turn left or</u> <u>right onto Louisiana Street from 3rd Street.</u> You will pick up at <u>Louisiana Street</u> <u>playground gate</u> After drop off/pick up proceed north.
- 4th/5th/6th Grade Blue Alley
 - o Approach from the <u>east in the <u>left lane</u> on 3rd Street. Turn RIGHT into the alley behind the school. After drop off/pick up proceed through the alley to 2nd Street. Turn left onto 2nd Street, which is a one-way street going west.</u>
- 7th/8th/9th Grade Orange 3rd Street (heading east towards Main St.)
 - o Approach from the <u>west</u> on 3rd Street. After drop off/pick up proceed east.





Arrival/Dismissal Zone Guidelines

- Students may be dropped off at 7:20am (there is no supervision before 7:20am)
- Students <u>MUST</u> be picked up by <u>4:00pm</u> unless enrolled in IGNITE after School program
- Drivers are to stay in the car.
- Be ready to load and unload quickly.
- Be mindful of which side the students should exit the car from:
 - o Alley: Left Side
 - o Louisiana Street: Right Side
 - Third Street: Right Side
- Do not use the streets immediately around eStem to get to the drop off/pick up points; you need to start several blocks away to help ease traffic congestion.
- Do not block intersections, crosswalks or the entrance/exits to any businesses.
- Be mindful of pedestrians.
- Pull forward as far as possible.
- Do not park in the alley or the northbound lane of Louisiana
- Display your dismissal number visibly in the right corner of the windshield.

<u>Dismissal Terminology</u>

These students dismiss from the K6 Building:

Bus Rider – any student in K-6 who has a bus pass and rides the Rock Region Metro bus

<u>Daycare Van Rider</u> – any student in K-6 who is enrolled in a day care or after school program and will be picked up by their van/bus.

<u>Car rider</u> – any student in K-6 with any siblings that dismiss at the K6 building who will be picked up in our K6 car pool

<u>Walker</u> – any student in K-6 <u>without</u> a Jr. High sibling who has parental permission to leave our campus without adult supervision

These students dismiss from the Junior High Building:

<u>Jr. High walker</u> – any student in K-6 with a Jr. High sibling that has permission to be escorted across the street to the Jr. High and is allowed to leave the campus with their sibling without adult supervision

<u>Jr. High car rider</u> – <u>All students in 4th, 5th, or 6th grade who have a Jr. High sibling</u> will be escorted across the street to be picked up in the Jr. High dismissal area with their sibling
