#### **Overview of Concurrent Credit**

Concurrent credit (CC) refers to the **credit hours** earned when a high school student takes a course that simultaneously counts for both **high school and college credit**.

These courses are taken on a high school campus and taught by a **high school teacher** who has a **master's degree** in the content area or **at least 18 graduate hours in the content area**.

eHS co-seats AP and Concurrent Credit courses and **partners with UA-Little Rock** for students to earn college credit.

# Concurrent Credit Application Process/Responsibilities for Students and Parents

Step 1 - Apply for Admission by August 11

Step 2 - Qualify via ACT or Accuplacer by August 25

Step 3 - Complete Consent Forms by August 23

Step 4 - Register for Classes on August 25

Step 5 - Pay for Classes by September 15



### Step #1- Apply for Admission to UA-Little Rock Due Date- August 11

- Student who have not yet been admitted to UA-Little Rock must apply here.
- Students who have already been admitted to UA-Little Rock, but did NOT enroll in a CC course during the 2022-2023 school year should <u>re-apply</u> and choose the "I am a Returning Student" option.
- Students who have already been admitted to UA-Little Rock AND enrolled in a CC course during the 2022-2023 school year can skip this step.



# Step #2- Qualify for CC via ACT or Accuplacer Due Date- August 25

#### Registering for the Accuplacer

Students who do not have a qualifying ACT or Accuplacer score must take the Accuplacer. Students will be offered the Accuplacer at **eHS will for on-site testing in July & August.** You will be receiving an email with dates for testing. Students testing at eHS MUST provide the following information during their testing session:

- ➤ UA-Little Rock T-Number (Received upon acceptance to UA Little Rock.)
- First and Last Name
- > DOB
- > Race
- > Gender
- Name(s) of eStem class(es) eligible for CC



## **Step #3** - Complete Consent Forms **Due Date- August 23**

Students must complete CC consent forms for both eStem and UA-Little Rock.

# Step #4 - Register for Classes Due Date- August 25

Assistance will be available **on-site** at eHS as students register for their CC course(s) through their **BOSS** accounts.

UA-Little Rock will reset **students' BOSS PIN** to be their birthdays in the **mmddyy** format.

# **Step #5** - Pay for Classes **Due Date- September 15**

Per the university, parents will **submit payment** for CC courses **directly to eStem** who will then pay UA-Little Rock. The cost of each CC course is \$100.00, plus a \$5.00 electronic processing fee for a **total of \$105.00 per course**.

Once students have completed registration, parents may begin submitting payment via credit card by clicking <a href="https://example.com/here">here</a>. Please ensure that you are paying for the correct number of CC courses in which your child is enrolled.

Students who **do not submit payment** to eStem **by September 15 will be dropped** from the opportunity to receive their **UA-Little Rock concurrent credit**, but will remain in the eStem course for high school credit.
