- 1. Start with a HOOK: a quotation from the book, vivid description of a character, or question.
- 2. Mention the Title and author.
- 3. Summarize the basics the setting, key characters, and conflicts without giving away too much.
- 4. Offer your feelings, opinions, and ratings what made this book stand out?
- 5. Finish strong, but don't tell the ending! You want you audience to read the book.
- 6. Be enthusiastic. Match your tone to the book and make it seem worth reading.
