

Summers County Board of Education

Scope: This policy is established to make known the express authorization by the county board for the superintendent to act in the absence of county board policy and the protocol for informing the county board of the need for county board policies or administrative policies.

ACTION BY SUPERINTENDENT IN ABSENCE OF POLICY

When action must be taken within the school system in cases where the Board of Education has provided no policy to guide administrative action, the Superintendent of Schools shall have the power to act, but his/her decisions shall be subject to review by action of the Board of Education at its regular meeting.

It shall be the duty of the Superintendent of Schools to inform the Board of Education promptly of such action and the need for a policy.
