ENERGY CONSERVATION

It is the purpose of the Summers County Board of Education Energy Policy to conserve energy by operating all buildings in the county as efficiently as possible without sacrificing the health or comfort of the building occupants.

Definitions:

Energy - All types of fuel and energy used in the buildings under the management of the Summers County Board of Education.

Energy Consumption Report - A report of the total energy consumed by each building operated by the Summers County Board of Education during each fiscal year. This report will be compiled from data provided by the maintenance supervisor and submitted to the accounts payable clerk. The final report will be submitted to the Superintendent at the end of each fiscal year.

Preventive Maintenance - Tasks assigned at the school level which aid in saving energy. Items such as oiling motors, repairing weather striping, caulking or cracks and holes, checking light fixtures, checking the heat temperatures on hot water heaters and checking of thermostats. These tasks shall be assigned to some person in the building by the building principal.

Audit - Each school principal will develop his/her own check list.
