Parental Involvement and Title 1 Hoopeston Area CUSD #11

Hoopeston Area CUSD #11 is committed to providing quality education for every child in the district. Our students, parents/guardians, staff, administration, Board of Education, and community are working together to ensure that we provide the best educational environment possible for our district stakeholders. Everyone gains when the school, home, and community work together to promote high achievement for our children. Neither home nor school can do the job alone. Parents play an extremely important role as their children's first teachers. Their support for their children and for the school is critical to their children's success every step along the way.

PART 1 DISTRICT EXPECTATIONS

Hoopeston Area School District CUSD #11 agrees to implement the following requirements:

- 1. HASD will provide programs, activities, and procedures for the involvement of parents in all its district Title 1 programs. These programs will be planned and implemented with meaningful consultation of parents/guardians of participating children.
- 2. HASD will work with its schools to ensure that the required school-level Parental Involvement Policy and Procedures meet Title 1 requirements and include, as a component, a school-parent compact.

- 3. HASD will hold an annual meeting to inform parents of the school's participation in Title 1, Part A programs, and to explain the programs. Input will also be sought from parents of students served by the Title 1 schools for the purpose of revising and updating the Parental Involvement Plan. The district will invite all parents and will encourage them to attend with the help of the school website and phone calls.
- 4. HASD will provide parents of participating children information in a timely manner about Title 1, Part A programs. The following information will be communicated to parents:
 - a. Information letters about programs their children participate in
 - b. Quarterly report cards
 - c. Benchmark information
 - d. Progress Monitoring information
 - e. State assessment information
 - f. Parental communication tools such as Class DoJo, emails, phone calls, etc., will be utilized
- 5. HASD will provide opportunities for regular meetings for parents and guardians to formulate suggestions and to participate, as appropriate, in decisions about the education of their children through:
 - a. Parent Orientation events
 - b. Family engagement activities
 - c. Newsletters
 - d. Parent Teacher conferences
 - e. Scheduled meetings between parents and school officials
 - f. Parental communication tools such as Class DoJo, emails, phone calls, etc., will be utilized
- 6. HASD will provide each guardian timely notice when their child has been assigned or has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher who is not highly qualified.

- 7. HASD will take the following actions to ensure that information related to the school and parent programs, meetings, and other activities are sent to guardians of participating children in an understandable and uniform format including alternative formats upon request, and, to the extent practicable, in a language parents can understand:
 - a. Newsletters
 - b. Websites
 - c. Interpreters
- 8. If the district program plan is not satisfactory to the guardians of the participating children, submit any guardian comments on the plans to the district administrator.

PART III ACCESSIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

In carrying out the parental involvement requirements, districts and schools, to the extent practicable, shall provide full opportunities for the participation of guardians with children with limited English proficiency, parents of children with disabilities, and parents of migratory children, including providing information and school reports in a format and, to the extent practicable, in a language such parents can understand.

PART IV ADOPTION
