The regular board meeting was held March 14, 2022 in the school cafeteria. The meeting was called to order at 6:31 p.m. by President Laura Clark. Board members present: Laura Clark; Carl McGill; Cindy Parks; Janet Banister; Steve Dunham; and Dave Phillips.

Prayer was led by Carl McGill, and the Pledge of Allegiance was said by all.

Carl McGill made a motion to approve the minutes for the February 15, 2022 board meeting. Dave Philips seconded the motion. Motion passed with a 6-0 vote.

Steve Dunham made a motion to approve the February 28, 2022 financial report. Carl McGill seconded the motion. Motion passed with a 6-0 vote.

Janet Banister made a motion to approve the 2022-2023 school calendar with four-day week as presented. Dave Phillips seconded the motion. Motion passed with a 6-0 vote.

Carl McGill made a motion to accept the Winter Board Policy Updates. Cindy Parks seconded the motion. Motion passed with a 6-0 vote.

Curriculum Coordinator (Autumn Reeder) updated the board on steps the District is taking to increase test scores, and steps being taken to assist our teachers in improving academics in our district.

Federal Programs Coordinator (Stephanie Clark) updated the board on steps the District is taking to ensure Blevins Schools remains in compliance with all Federal and State Requirements.

No Superintendent report.

Laura Clark made a motion to accept the resignation of Brandi Myers effective March 10, 2022. The motion also included moving Krista Milner to Dyslexia with a 220 day contract, and moving Kathleen Wicker to math interventionist with a 200 day contract for the 2022-2023 school. Also, Heather Hinton was hired as a paraprofessional with a 178 day contract; Kathelyn Sherman was hired as elementary teacher; and Madison Dixon was hired as art teacher for the 2022-2023 school year. Deanne Johnson was hired as a custodian effective April 4, 2022 with a 240 day contract. In addition, the contract for Fredriqua Monk (elementary counselor) was changed to 220 days for the 2022-2023 school year. Cindy Parks seconded the motion. Motion passed with a 6-0 vote.
