The mission of the Blevins School District's Parent and Family Engagement Committee is to team up with student, parent, and community team members to improve parent and community involvement.

- The parent and community involvement committee will meet in the month of September and set other meeting dates on that meeting to monitor and set up goals to encourage and increase parental and community involvement as well as discuss strategies to maintain and improve procedures already in place.
- The District family and community involvement plan will be available for review at the yearly Blevins School Report to the public on October 9, 2023.
- Blevins School District provides opportunities for parents to sign-up for volunteer services and to join the district Parent Teacher Organization at open house. These sign up sheets will also be available at the Districts yearly report to the public and student parent teacher conferences.
- Members of the District's Parent and Family Engagement Committee are made up of all district and community team members.
- Parental needs assessment surveys will be given each semester.

The Blevins School District will ensure that all professional development requirements are met by teachers and administrators by requiring all administrators, teachers, and district support staff to attend parental involvement training and are trained to assist parents with:

- parents playing a role is developing student learning and develop ways to encourage attendance
- train staff in various ways to communicate with parents and community
- develop a volunteer program to assist district staff
- utilize various ways of communication with district staff and parents through social media, districts webpage, school app, Swift12 alert systems, and staff emails
- welcome parents to the district to work as equal partners
- develop an open line of communication for parent and team member concerns and those concerns will be addressed in a timely manner

The Blevins School District will provide the necessary tools to help build on parent and student proportions.

- The Blevins School District parental involvement committee will meet multiple times a year to set up goals and guidelines for increased student success, student attendance, increased reading and parental involvement.
- Blevins School District will provide parents with individual student academic test results and explain those results.
- The district webpage will provide helpful information for parents to track student achievement and progress.
- The Blevins School District will provide a description and explanation of the tests used to measure student progress and achievement levels of challenging state academic standards. The progress will be observed through student progress reports, quarterly grades, NWEA testing, ACT Aspire testing and student AR reading goals during Open House and Parent/Teacher Conferences.
- Teachers will provide information on website that will aide in student instruction.

- Automated text/phone calls will be used to remind parents and students of important upcoming dates and information.
