Education Resolution of Support for Military Children and Families

WHEREAS, more than 14,000 Arkansans exhibit profound courage and selflessness by serving in the armed forces; and

WHEREAS, more than 5,200 military children attend public school in the State of Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, approximately 255 students from military families attend Greenwood Public Schools; and

WHEREAS, Greenwood Schools ranks 5th in the state enrollment of military children and is in close proximity to Fort Chaffee Joint Maneuver Training Center and Ebbing Air National Guard Base; and

WHEREAS, military children face unique challenges related to military transitions and parental deployment; and

WHEREAS, military children and their families serve as an essential source of support and encouragement for armed service members; and

WHEREAS, military children should be acknowledged for the sacrifices they make and celebrated for the courage they display as the children of our nation's armed service members; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Greenwood School District School Board of Education recognizes and salutes military children and expresses its support for military children and families.
