

Registration

All Pre-K through 12th grade students need to register on August 2, 2021 through August 17, 2021 from 9:00a.m. to 12:00p.m.. PREVENTION

Practices to Prevent the Virus from Entering the School

Quarantine Guidelines

- Teachers and staff must report to the school nurse and their immediate supervisor if they
 themselves are lab confirmed with COVID-19, and, if so, they must remain off campus
 until they meet the criteria for re-entry as noted below. Additionally, they must report to
 the school nurse and their immediate supervisor if any member in their immediate
 household is lab confirmed, and, if so, must remain off campus until they meet the
 criteria for re-entry.
- Parents must ensure they do not send a child to school in any of the following circumstances
 - 1. The child is lab confirmed to have COVID-19
 - 2. Any member of the household is lab confirmed with COVID-19

Criteria for Re-Entry

- Any individual who themselves are lab-confirmed to have COVID-19 or live in a
 household of an individual that is lab confirmed, must stay off campus until the nurse
 screens the individual to determine if the following conditions for campus re-entry have
 been met:
 - 1. At-least one day (24 hours) has passed since recovery (resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications)
 - 2. The individual has improvement in symptoms (e.g. cough, shortness of breath)
 - 3. At least ten days have passed since symptoms first appeared.

MITIAGATION

Practices to Mitigate the Likelihood of COVID-19 Spread Inside the School

Health and Hygiene Practices

- Schools will have hand sanitizer in classrooms, halls, cafeteria and common areas throughout the campus
- Students, staff and visitors will be encouraged to sanitize and/or wash their hands frequently
 - Students will have teh opportunity for hand washing for at=least 20 seconds at-;east two times a day, in addition to being encouraged to wash hands after using the restroom and before eating
 - 2. Students, staff and visitors will be encouraged to cover coughs and sneezes with a tissue, and if not available, covered in their elbows. Used tissues should be

thrown in the trash, hands should be washed immediately with soap and water for at-least 20 seconds, or hand sanitizer should be used

- Staff will have access to disinfectant wipes to sanitize high touch surfaces and shared objects regularly.
- Vehicles, especially route buses and activity buses, will be regularly cleaned and sanitized after each route or activity to help prevent the spread of infectious disease.
- Custodians, staff and students will disinfect classrooms, desks, door handles, etc. regularly to mitigate the chances of viral or bacterial contamination.

Masks and Face Coverings

Masks and face coverings are optional for students, staff and visitors in district facilities, school buses and school events. We would encourage students, staff and visitors to take whatever precautions they feel comfortable with in light of COVID-19. Vega ISD will provide masks and face coverings if an individual needs one. As of June 5, 2021 per GA-36, school systems cannot require students or staff to wear masks or face coverings.

Learning Options

- → Face to Face Learning- Full time in-person on campus learning, with additional hygiene and disinfection procedures.
 - 1. Social distancing will be observed in areas where practical.
 - 2. Facial coverings will be provided for students, staff or guests if they choose to wear them.
 - 3. Students must bring a bottle to put their drinking water in using the hydration station.
 - 4. 90% attendance rule is in effect (TEC 25.092)
- → Virtual Learning- Will only be in effect if a student is guarantined with Covid-19.

Grading

Vega ISD sends out progress reports to parents/guardians on the 3 weeks, 6 weeks, and 9 weeks, and the dates for those can be found on the district calendar. Parents also have access to student grades through Parent Portal. If parents need assistance accessing the Parent Portal, contact your student's campus secretary (806) 267-2123.

Extracurricular

Vega ISD will follow all UIL guidelines for extracurricular activities in the 2021-22 school year.

<u>Technology</u>

Vega ISD is continually working to improve its technology in the classroom and for the students. Information concerning technology use fees and distribution will be provided to parents by their child's home campus.

Transportation

Vega ISD does provide transportation to their rural students. If your student is experiencing any of the Covid-19 symptoms, please keep that student at home and contact the campus secretary.

Continuity of Services

In response to COVID-19 and the impact it had on our staff and students, Vega ISD will ensure continuity of services for our employees and students in the following ways:

Supporting VISD Employees

Vega ISD strongly believes that teachers are vital to the success of our students; furthermore, VISD believes that ALL of our employees are crucial in assisting our students to reach their potential.

VISD strives to give teachers a voice in and out of their classroom. VISD will continue to seek opportunities to elicit feedback from our faculty/staff, and to act upon this feedback in a constructive and thoughtful way. The District will also provide safety and security for our faculty/staff by taking measures against both potential disease outbreaks by maintaining clean facilities, vehicles, and equipment, but also against other threats (e.g. active shooter). Vega ISD is also committed to meeting the needs of the teachers and their curriculum from a technological standpoint. Our teachers have access to at least a desktop computer, laptop computer, and/or Chromebook, plus each room is outfitted with a smart board/interactive TV. A district-wide

Director of Instructional Technology is also employed full-time by the District to assist in training and trouble- shooting for the instructors.

Vega ISD also employees a full-time nurse on campus. This will be helpful in meeting the physical well-being of our faculty/staff and students should they need immediate assistance in this matter. Finally, VISD employed a second full-time Counselor to help meet the mental and emotional needs of our faculty/staff and students.

Extended and Targeted Instructional Time & Rigorous Instructional Material

Vega ISD has focused on closing gaps of students, especially in Reading and Writing. The district employs two Special Education-certified teachers to assist students in a Reading Intervention time. The district also employs a trained Dyslexia specialist to further meet our students' needs in that area. Finally, by the 2022-23 school year, every Kindergarten through 3rd Grade teacher will have successfully completed the *Reading Academy*.

Mental and Emotional Needs and Resources for Students and Staff

Vega ISD realizes that the social and emotional needs of our students deserve as much of our
attention as the academic needs. VISD employs a full time counselor. Mrs. Cook does character
Ed training with all Elementary and JH students. VISD will continue to seek informative ways to
meet the emotional needs of our students.
