- V. ACADEMIC SHARING
 - **A.** Mr. Josephson Presented Academic Sharing Survey Results. Surveys were given out to Teachers, Students and Parents on Academic Sharing. The main issues stressed throughout the survey were:
 - 1) Need to continue to find better ways to facilitate access to teachers and students, 2) Need to continue collaboration and communication to keep consistency in academics, expectations, and discipline, and
 - 3) Need to continue to explore ways to expand sharing and opportunities.
 - B. Mr. Simington presented Academic Sharing Courses, Scheduling and Activity Participation. Mr. Simington shared the new classes offered in 2016-17. Some of the classes were: Modern Problems, Agribusiness Management, Small Engines, Applied Sewing Tech & Textiles, Health and Healthy Lifestyles and Management. The total number of students served for G-T -101, R-A - 59. Classes offered In House 70+, Odysseyware - 40+, ILCC - 40+. The total classes taken G-T - 46, R-A -23. Total students G-T - 55 and R-A - 17. The numbers for activities were about the same with Volleyball and Girls Basketball increasing.
 - C. Mr. Woiwood And Josh Bader Presented Academic Sharing Financials Mr. Woiwood explained and compared figures for Academic Sharing and Enrollment for both Ruthven-Ayrshire and Graettinger-Terril. Josh Bader of the AEA presented the Unspent Authorized Budget, Targeted Unspent Balances, and Supplemental Weighting for both Ruthven-Ayrshire and Graettinger-Terril. The cost per student was also presented.
