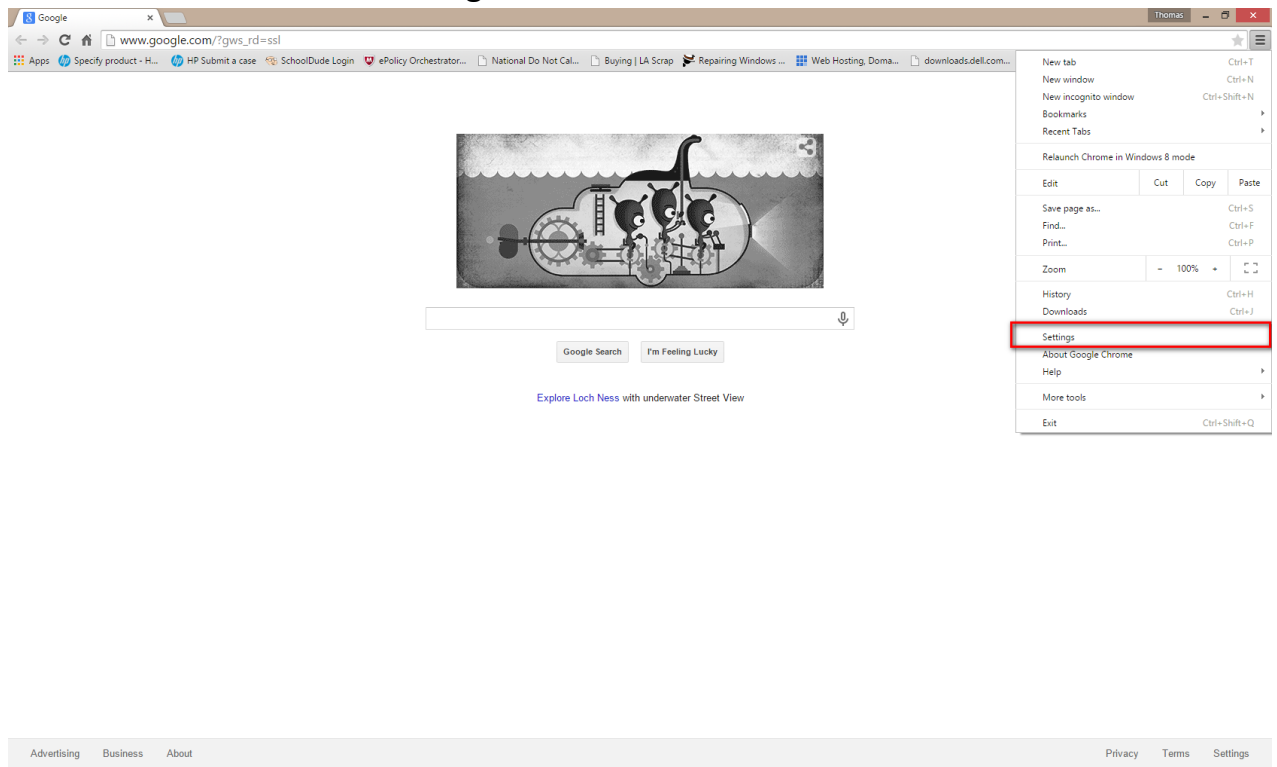


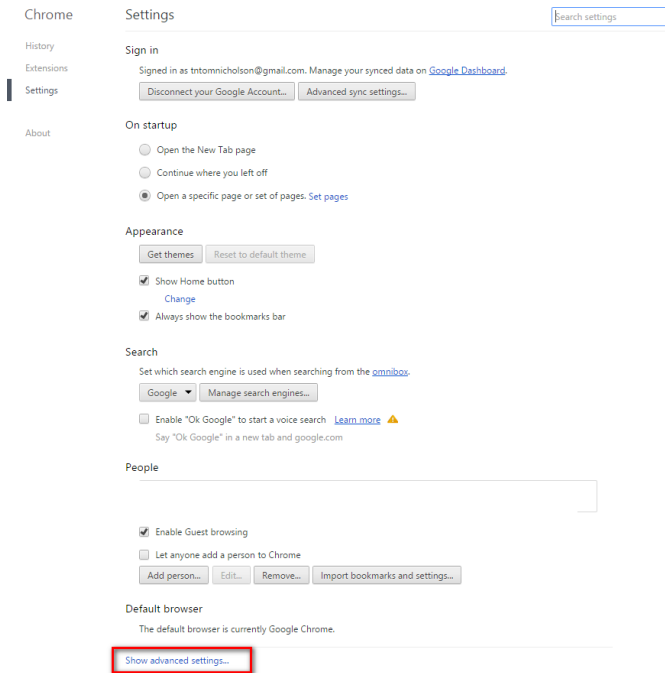
Disable password Save on Google Chrome and Internet explorer

Google Chrome:

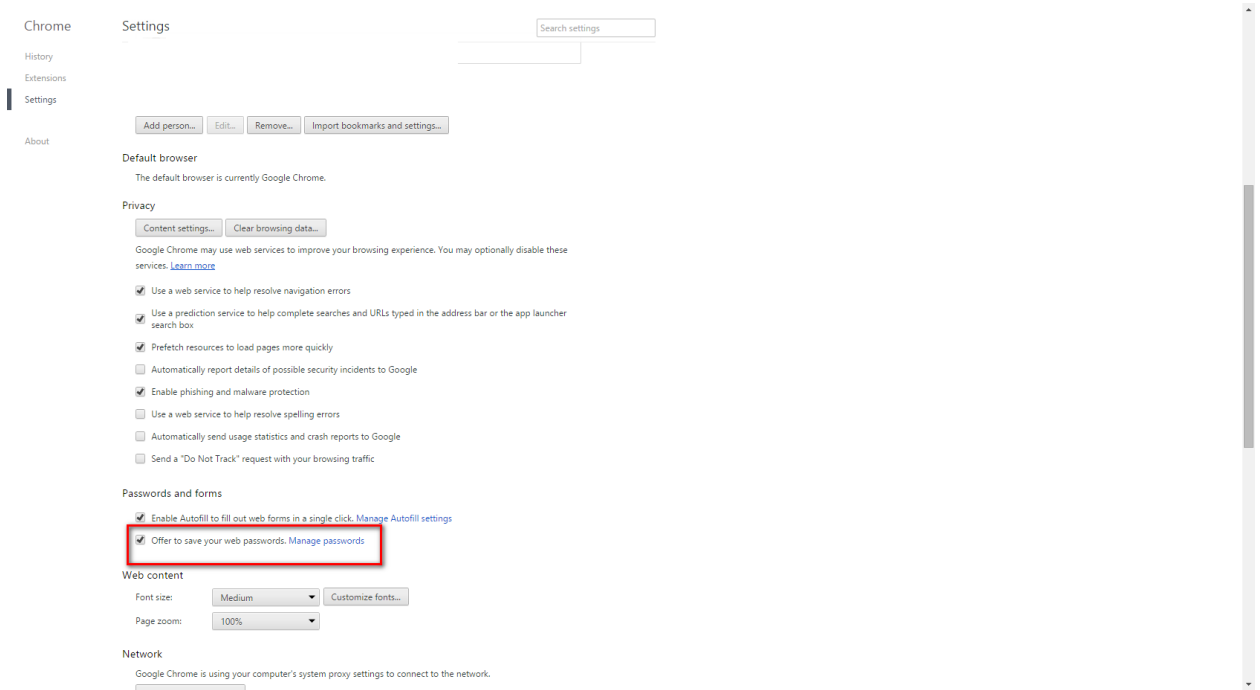
1. Open Google chrome and click on the box on the top right with three horizontal lines. Choose settings.



2. In the chrome settings menu click the blue words at the bottom that say show advanced settings.

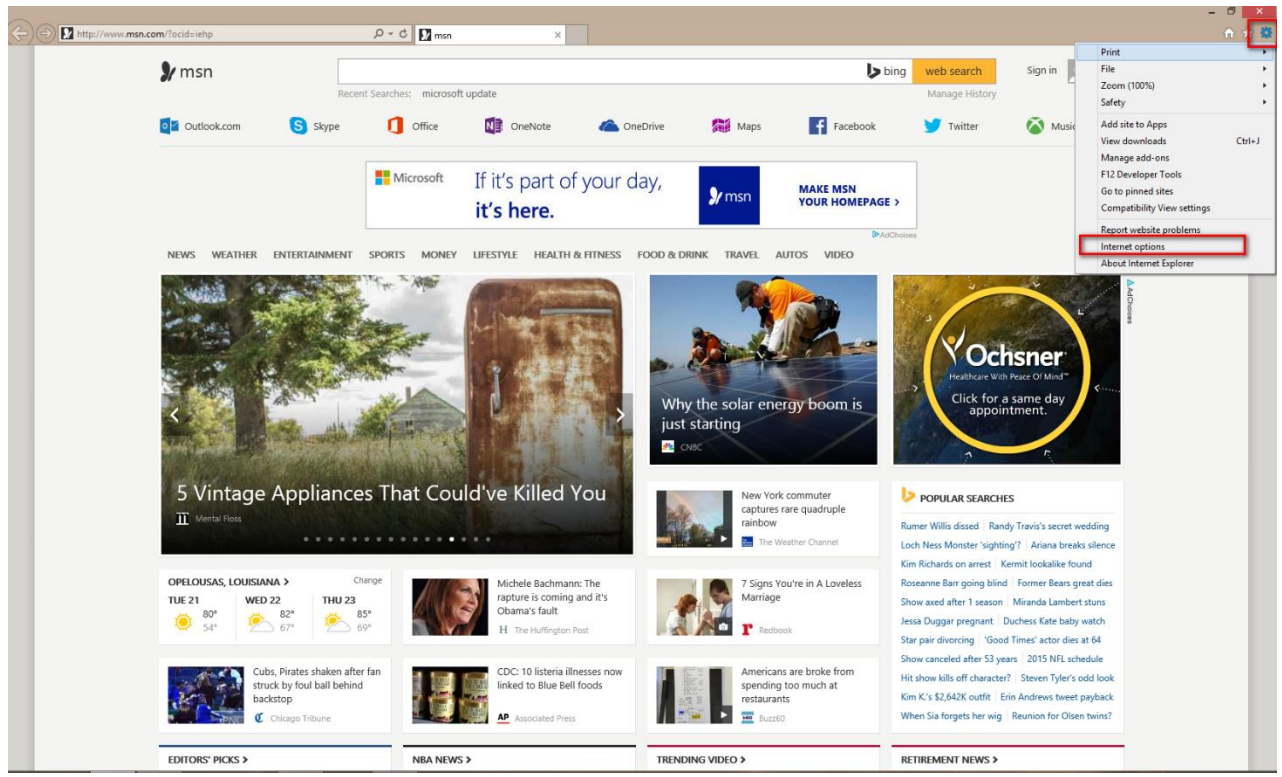


3. Under advanced settings un-check the box beside the option that says offer to save web passwords.

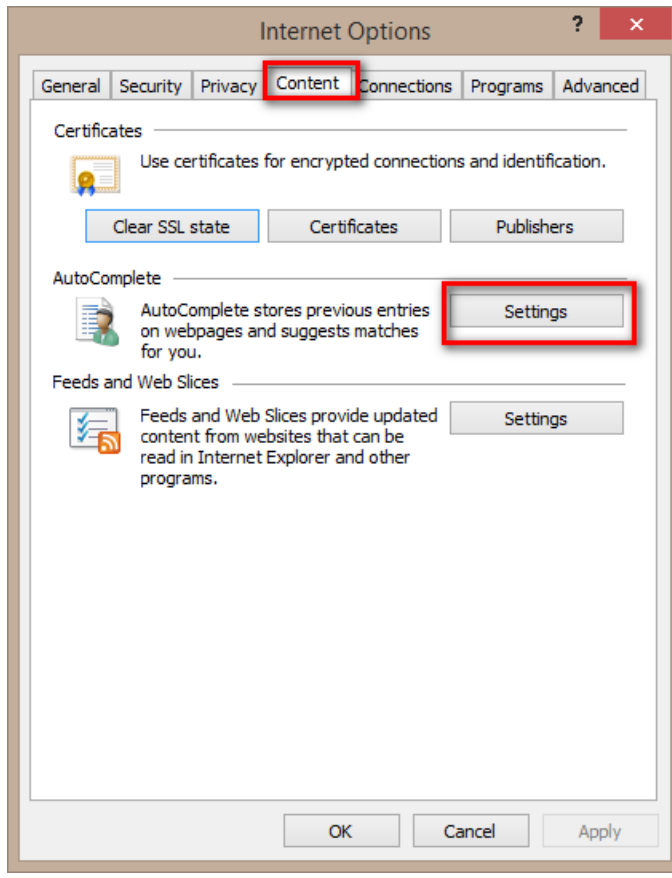


Internet Explorer:

1. Open internet explorer and click on the small cog in the upper right hand corner and select internet options.



2. Click on the content tab under the internet options window. Then click on settings under the auto complete section.



3. Uncheck the box beside the words user names and passwords on forms. This will disable the browser from asking to save passwords on webpages.
