
Copy Data from XP Computer to Win 7


- 1. These instructions only work if you are logged into the new domain using the user's three initials and last four of their ssn. Please don't attempt until this has been completed.
- 2. Make sure you are on an XP machine. If your see the word start on the menu, that is an xp computer.
- 3. First find out what user your data is located on.
- 4. Click on the start button then click on My computer




5. Open the local disk C drive



6. Open the folder documents and settings. In the documents and settings



folder is a list of every user on that computer. **EVERY Computer has a different list of users**. Find your user log on. If you logged on as administrator it will be administrator.




- 7. Open the folders until you find yours.

- 12. Once your into your new computer click on the start button




13. Click on computer on the right
