Jim Thorpe Area School District Automobile Regulations

Students may drive to school and park in the student parking lot B after registering with the Director of Security. Registration will take place during the first week of school. A parking permit form can be picked up in the Office. A car tag will be issued after the following conditions have been met:

1. Completion of registration
2. Proof of liability insurance
3. Presentation of valid Pennsylvania Drivers License
4. The parking tag is to be displayed on the rearview mirror. A \$5.00 fee is charged to replace a lost tag.

Driving an automobile to school is a privilege, which is susceptible to revocation/suspension for any of, but not limited to, the following violations:

1. Excessive unexcused absences and/or tardiness to school.
2. Out-of-school suspensions or frequent In-school suspensions.
3. Not parking properly in stalls.
4. Going to and or moving automobile during the day without permission from the office.
5. Violation of the Pa. Motor Vehicle Code including but not limited to speeding on school property

School officials are authorized to search a student's personal possessions or motor vehicle parked on school property when there is reasonable suspicion that the student is violating the law, school policy or school rules, or poses a threat to the health, safety or welfare of the school student population.

The above will be strictly enforced and owners of vehicles will be susceptible to a fine and/or towing at owner's expense. The school district is not responsible for any missing articles or damage to any vehicle.

If a student's driving privilege has been revoked or suspended, he/she is not to park on school property nor are they to drive through the school campus.
