Karen will be on site Monday, January 3 and Tuesday, January 4.

If your child is not tested prior to the return of school, it is ok, and he/she will not be turned away from the classroom, but if your child exhibits any of the symptoms for COVID-19, please keep them at home until the symptoms subside. Our main priority is to keep your children and families safe, along with our staff and their families, by controlling the spread at school.

We have done an amazing job of managing the Pandemic for the first half of the year, and we would like to continue for the remainder of the school year. At this time, masks are still required indoors at school and hopefully that will be lifted in the near future. Thanks for your continued support and willingness to keep our doors open.
