A reminder that KES students will be participating in our Welcome Back Winter Carnival outdoor learning activities tomorrow from 12:15 - 1:30. Please dress children in appropriate layered winter clothing.

The Maine DOE and CDC have updated the Standard Operating Procedures which Katahdin Schools will be adhering to immediately. The updates include:

- Reduced periods of isolation and quarantine for students and staff consistent with recently updated guidance from the U.S. CDC
- An updated definition of outbreak as related to school cases
- Close contact exposure will not be considered in an outdoor setting or on a school bus, where the Federal government requires masks be worn.

• For schools participating in pooled testing there has been an update to the "test to stay" program to enable more students to stay in the classroom.
