VIRTUAL INSTRUCTION

As per Dr. Caputo's email on 1/1/2022, The Metuchen Public Schools will operate virtually for students on Monday (1/3), Tuesday (1/4), and Wednesday (1/5).

Instruction Expectations

Students will log onto each class period's Google Meet for attendance and for instruction. Instruction should follow the workshop model where there is a balance between whole group and small group/independent activities. Not all work will be accomplished on Google Meet. Assignments will be posted on Google Classroom.

We will return to in-person instruction for everyone on Thursday (1/6).

STUDENT VIRTUAL ATTENDANCE

Teachers are expected to take attendance for each class period and mark attendance on Genesis. Period 1 teachers will take both homeroom and class period attendance.

WHEN WE'RE BACK ON THURSDAY

The expectations are as follows:

- All students are required to fill out the daily health screening on Genesis BEFORE arrival to school.
- All students are required to bring and wear a properly fitted facemask. This means that both the nose and mouth are covered.
