HONOR GROUP

The following policies have been adopted by the School Board to be used in determining an Honor Group from each year's graduating class:

- 1. Any student with GPA 3.5 or higher, or top 10% through the third nine weeks of senior year shall be the Honor Group.
- 2. Only academic course grades will be used in establishing averages. (Phy. Ed., Health, Chorus, Band, Drivers Education, etc. will not be used.)
- 3. The Administration will review the records of transfer students, in the junior or senioryear, who may be eligible for the Honor Group.
- 4. Speaker or speakers representing the group will be selected by the honor group and the High School Principal.
- 5. The names of students in the Honor Group will be presented by the Principal to the Board at their regular meeting in April.
- 6. No correspondence courses will be used in determining the final standing of a student.
