

## HONOR GROUP

The following policies have been adopted by the School Board to be used in determining an Honor Group from each year's graduating class:

1. Any student with GPA 3.5 or higher, or top 10% through the third nine weeks of senior year shall be the Honor Group.
2. Only academic course grades will be used in establishing averages. (Phy. Ed., Health, Chorus, Band, Drivers Education, etc. will not be used.)
3. The Administration will review the records of transfer students, in the junior or senior year, who may be eligible for the Honor Group.
4. Speaker or speakers representing the group will be selected by the honor group and the High School Principal.
5. The names of students in the Honor Group will be presented by the Principal to the Board at their regular meeting in April.
6. No correspondence courses will be used in determining the final standing of a student.
