- 1. <u>Vendor 1</u> was low bid and installed a new playground at Bixby. Ms Chambers, Kvach and the architect went to inspect this structure and approved it as an equal. This company is from Missouri.
- 2. <u>Vendor 2</u> was only \$535.32 above the low bid. This vendor has installed the product at ECEC which has proven to be a good product. His bid includes yearly inspections and repair on the equipment during warranty. This company is from Dallas, Tx.
- 3. **Vendor 3** was the specified structure to match. This vendor is from Broken Arrow.
- 4. <u>Vendor 4</u> is an unknown vendor and there was a structure at Holland Hall but since they were high bidder, there was no visual inspection of the site.

Both Vendors 1 and 2 substituted play equipment and turf when they did not have the exact match of what was specified. Turf on both vendors were approved and they submitted the same product which we felt was superior to what we had specified.

Vendor 1 included 2 pieces of equipment that did not meet specs and we did not approve.

Vendor 2 vendor also included substitute items that were approved.

Both vendors had equipment that was equal, if not superior to what was specified.

Rationale: Based on this information:

- 1. We recommend Vendor #2, Child's Play because all the substituted equipment was approved, they are a known vendor, have performed well, and they included yearly inspections on their playground equipment in their bid.
- 2. We rejected Vendor #1 because they submitted equipment that was not approved because the equipment was not age appropriate by Ms Chambers.
