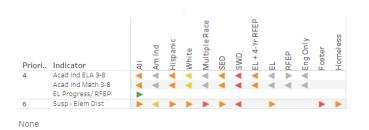

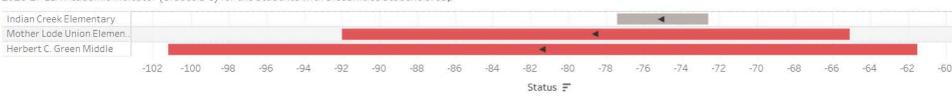
Dashboard Analysis

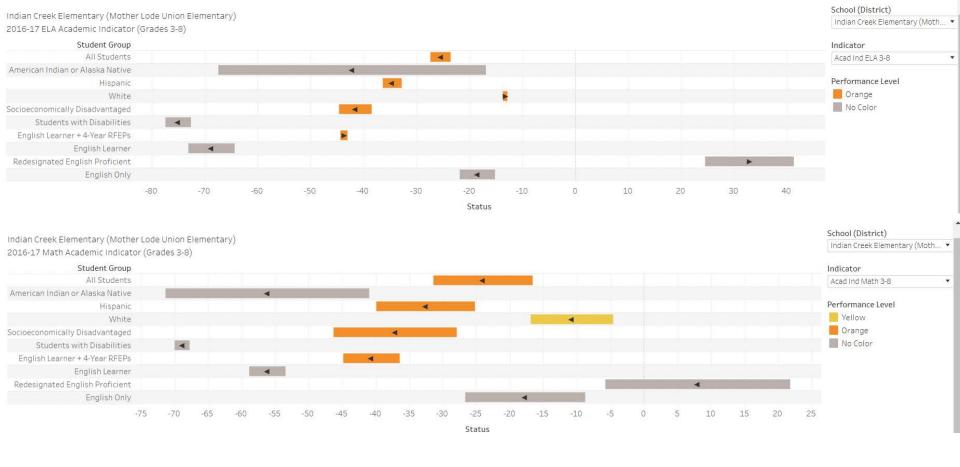
2016-17 ELA Academic Indicator (Grades 3-8) for the Students with Disabilities Student Group

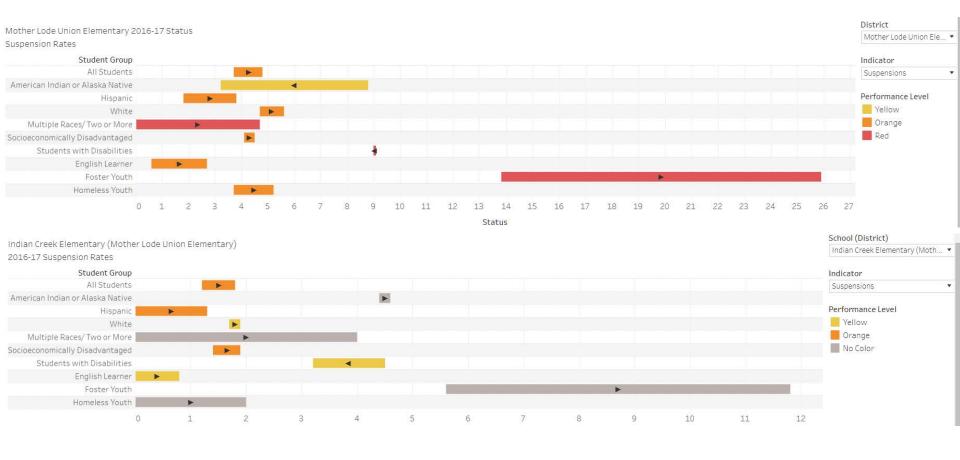
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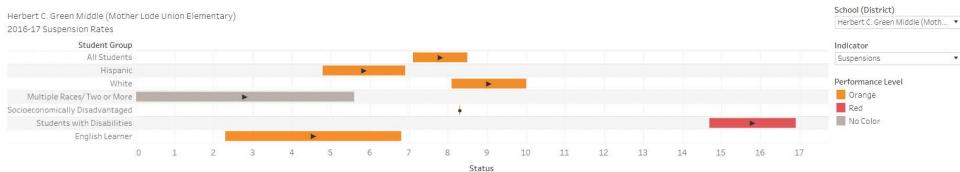

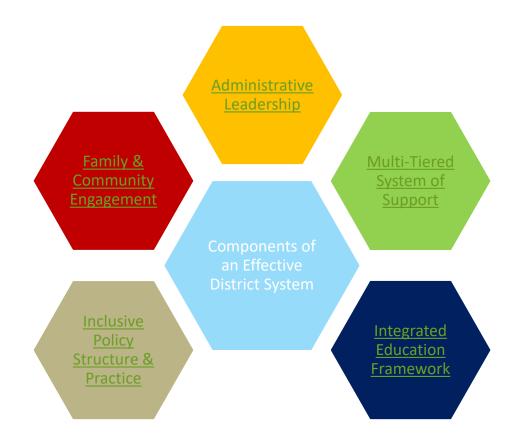
