2016 & 2017 Student Survey Data & 2017-20 LCAP Timeline

May 10, 2017

As you know we annually survey our students. The survey has not changed in the four years we've been administering the surveys so we can compare data from year to year. As part of the annual LCAP process, the LCAP-BACT Team analyzed the 2017 student survey results and compared them to the 2016 student survey results.

Our students in grades 5-8 take the CA Healthy Kids Survey. There is a survey for grades 5 and 6 and a different survey for grades 7 and 8. For 2017, there are no results for grade 6 as they took the incorrect survey. Please see all of the student survey data for HGMS for grades 5-8 attached. An area of concern is the responses of 5<sup>th</sup> grade students which showed a decrease of 6% or more over responses in 2016 for 5 questions.

Please see all of the results of the student survey data for ICES grades 3 and 4 attached. Highlights are:

- Teachers treat students fairly from 66% to 79%
- Teacher or other Adult treats all students with respect from 60% to 75%
- Students use technology every day/almost every day from 50% to 76%
- Teachers use technology every day/almost every day from 80% to 86%

## The timeline for the 2017-20 LCAP is:

- Draft LCAP to be distributed for another round of stakeholder input May 15-26
- LCAP-BACT Team Meeting May 23 to review the draft together
- Written responses to stakeholders and edits to the 2017-2020 LCAP as appropriate
- Public Hearing of the 2017-2020 LCAP before the Board June 14 and before the Board for Action June 28
