## **Quitman ISD Health Response Protocols**

(Please note these protocols and responses are subject to change)

- QISD ask that students, and employees to self-screen daily for COVID-19 symptoms.
- QISD will require students or employees that are running fever, vomiting, or have diarrhea to remain off campus until free from symptoms for 24 hours.
- Teachers, Staff, and Students should notify their campus principal if they are lab confirmed to have COVID-19, are actively sick or suspected of being sick with COVID-19.
- QISD will require positive confirmed individuals to:
  - o If symptomatic, at least 5 days have passed since symptom onset, and fever free\*, and other symptoms have improved.
  - o For those with no symptoms, at least 5 days after the day they tested positive
- Campus nurses and administration may require household-based close contact students to stay at home during the below stay-at-home period if they are in an area with high or rising COVID case rates
- QISD will notify all teachers, staff, and families of test confirmed Covid-19 cases is identified among students, teachers, or staff with a weekly report.
- QISD will work with local health authorities to determine the severity in our local area.
- QISD is required to report confirmed cases to the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS).
- Masks are optional for students and employees.
- QISD will continue to implement proactive strategies to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 such as handwashing, social distancing when appropriate, use of hand sanitizer, and sanitation of buses and facilities.
