Canadian Public Schools Activity Admissions Policy

The following policy shall govern the admission for all Canadian School OSSAA sponsored sports.

Admission for adults: High School events \$5.00

(Anyone not attending a post-secondary school and or 18 years of age and graduated from a public school)

Admission for non adults: High School event: \$3.00

(Anyone 18 years of age or younger and not graduating from a public school)

Admission for adults: Junior High & Elementary School events \$4.00

(Anyone not attending a post-secondary school and or 18 years of age and graduated from a public school)

Admission for non adults: Junior High & Elementary School event: \$2.00

(Anyone 18 years of age or younger and not graduating from a public school)

The following shall be entitled to be admitted without charge to regular season contests:

- 1. Canadian School employees
- 2. Canadian Board members/Spouses
- 3. Anyone possessing a current valid OSSAA or OSSBA membership pass with proof of identity
- 4. Senior Citizen Pass holders or Senior Citizens that show a valid driver's license

OSSAA playoff contests: State admission prices will be charged for any playoff contest and only OSSAA playoff passes can be accepted with a picture I.D> No exceptions as these are OSSAA rules.

Spouses of employees will pay full price

Children of employees will pay full price

Senior Citizens that do not show a current Senior Pass or a valid driver's license will pay full price

Senior Citizen Pass Request: Age to qualify now is 62. Must apply and receive pass from main school office during school business hours. Good only at Canadian School OSSAA SPONSORED events.
