The MHSAA reserves the right to promote and advance the membership's interests with publication information; exclusive arrangements to create recognition and exposure for school-sponsored activities; restrictive policies prohibiting exploitation and commercialization of MHSAA-sponsored tournaments; appropriate proprietary interests, and the use of images or transmissions identifying contest officials, spectators and member schools' students, personnel and marks.

To obtain membership, it is necessary for the Board of Education/Governing Body to adopt the following resolution for its junior high/middle and senior high schools. This resolution must be formally ratified by your Board of Education/Governing Body and properly signed. Please return one signed copy for our files and retain one copy for your files. WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Ovid-Elsie Area Schools has received a recommendation from its administration that three (3) instructional position(s) should be eliminated effective with the inception of the 2015-2016 program year; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Education is informed that the reasons underlying this administrative recommendation are:

- A. budgetary constraints projected to occur in the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015;
- B. anticipated enrollment levels for the 2015-2016 school year; and
- C. anticipated staffing requirements for the 2015-2016 program year, including the retention of effective teachers who are certified and qualified to instruct the planned educational program within the foregoing budgetary constraints.

WHEREAS, on the basis of the above recommendation, this Board of Education finds and determines that a reduction in teaching personnel should be effectuated for the 2015-2016 program year; and

WHEREAS, the administration of this School District has notified the affected teacher(s) of the contemplated staff reduction; and

WHEREAS, the administration of this School District has reviewed applicable legal standards, as well as the provisions of District Policy #3131.01 and has recommended the proposed reduction in personnel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The following tenured teachers are hereby placed on layoff status effective June 17, 2015, and his/her services are hereby discontinued effective as of that date and will not be required until further notice:
 - A. Barry Moore
 - B. Toni Thompson
 - C. Sarah Welch

- 2. That the identification of the above-named teacher(s) occur through application of District Policy # 3131.01, and is further based upon the need of this School District to retain effective teaching faculty members who possesses the necessary certification and qualifications to support the anticipated academic programming within the District for the 2015-2016 school year.
- 3. The Superintendent of this School District is hereby authorized and directed to notify the teacher(s) affected by this resolution, in writing, that they have been placed on layoff status effective June 30, 2015, and that his/her service has been discontinued and will not be required unless and until he/she is recalled to employment pursuant to the provisions of District Policy #3131.01.
- 4. The Superintendent of this School District is hereby authorized to take all other measures necessary and proper to implement the foregoing staff reduction.
- 5. All resolutions and parts of resolutions insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution be and the same are hereby rescinded.
