




MVESD COVID-19 Symptom Protocol Flowchart

If You Were Exposed (less than six feet away for a cumulative total of 15 minutes over a 24 hour period) to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19:

If you have been boosted, completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last six months, or completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last two months - wear a mask around others, avoid travel and avoid being around people who are at-risk for ten days. Test on day five, if possible.

If you completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over six months ago and are not boosted, completed the primary series of J&J over two months ago and are not boosted, or are unvaccinated: Stay home for five days. After that continue to wear a mask around others, avoid travel and avoid being around people who are at-risk for five additional days. If you can't quarantine you should wear a mask, avoid travel and avoid being around people who are at-risk for ten days. Test on day five, if possible.
