Is sick with Covid-19	Getting tested is strongly encouraged
Symptoms	If you stay home 3 or more days being sick with Covid symptoms it is strongly encouraged to provide a negative PCR test or a note from your healthcare provider.
	No Fever 100.4 F (or greater) in at least 48 hours without using any fever reducing medication and improvement AND improvement of symptoms

IF AN INDIVIDUAL IN HOUSEHOLD:	THEN YOUR STUDENT MAY RETURN WHEN:
Tested positive for Covid-19	At least 5 days have passed since the positive Covid 19 test was taken (Day 1 is the day the test was administered)
	Student Receives a negative test result from a PCR test taken on Day 5 or later
	No fever (100.4F or greater) in at least 48 hours without fever reducing medication and symptom free

^{*}Students will maintain a 6' distance from others while at lunch during the 5 days that they are wearing a mask.

Anyone waiting for the results of a pending Covid-19 test should stay home until the results are reported to the school.

^{*}Students participating in co-curricular activities and riding buses during the five days are also required to wear a mask. PLEASE NOTE: If a mask cannot be worn properly for 5 days, then the individual will need to remain home for the remainder of the 10 days. NO EXCEPTIONS or EXEMPTIONS
