

# Geneva Jt. 4 Woods School Revised Isolation Guidelines

IF STUDENT: THEN YOUR STUDENT MAY RETURN WHEN:	
Tested Positive for Covid-19 and is showing symptoms	<p>At least 5 days have passed since the positive test was taken (Day 1 is the day the test was taken-return to school on Day 6)</p> <p>No Fever (100.4 or greater) in at least 48 hours without the use of medication</p> <p>Symptom Free</p> <p>Follow any other guidelines given to you by your medical provider or the Health Department</p> <p>Per the CDC, must wear a mask for 5 days following isolation *</p>
Tested positive for Covid-19 and is not showing symptoms	<p>At least 5 days have passed since the positive Covid 19 test (Day 1 is the day the test was taken-return to school on Day 6)</p> <p>Follow any other guidelines given to you by your medical provider or the Health Department</p> <p>Per the CDC, must wear a mask for 5 days following isolation *</p>
Is sick with Covid-19 Symptoms	<p>Getting tested is strongly encouraged</p> <p>If you stay home 3 or more days being sick with Covid symptoms it is strongly encouraged to provide a negative PCR test or a note from your healthcare provider.</p> <p>No Fever 100.4 F (or greater) in at least 48 hours without using any fever reducing medication and improvement AND improvement of symptoms</p> <p>If you visit a doctor and are told you or your student have something other than Covid-19, (ex. Influenza) then you should follow the doctor's guidelines for return to school.</p>
Is sick with symptoms and tested NEGATIVE for Covid-19	<p>Stay home until feeling better and have not had a fever for 48 hours without using any medication to reduce fever.</p> <p>If you visit a doctor and are told you or your student has something other than Covid-19 (ex. Influenza) then you should follow the doctor's guidelines for return to school.</p>
IF AN INDIVIDUAL IN HOUSEHOLD: THEN YOUR STUDENT MAY RETURN WHEN:	
Tested positive for Covid-19	<p>At least 5 days have passed since the positive Covid 19 test was taken (Day 1 is the day the test was administered)</p> <p>Student Receives a negative test result from a PCR test taken on Day 5 or later</p> <p>No fever (100.4F or greater) in at least 48 hours without fever reducing medication and symptom free</p>

\*Students will maintain a 6' distance from others while at lunch during the 5 days that they are wearing a mask.

\*Students participating in co-curricular activities and riding buses during the five days are also required to wear a mask.

PLEASE NOTE: If a mask cannot be worn properly for 5 days, then the individual will need to remain home for the remainder of the 10 days. NO EXCEPTIONS or EXEMPTIONS

Anyone waiting for the results of a pending Covid-19 test should stay home until the results are reported to the school.
