Report promptly to all classes.



Check into Homeroom on time every day so that your attendance can be recorded.



Mute your microphone unless you are asking or responding to a question.



Wear your school uniform. If you are unable to wear your uniform, wear a plaincolored shirt (tank tops and tee-shirts with graphics are not permitted).



Keep your camera on for the entire class period unless you are told otherwise.



Work in a room with no distractions (pets, family members, tv, etc.) and make sure no one else is behind the screen during instruction.



Always be respectful and courteous to other students and teachers.



District devices should be used only for school-related work and study.



Students who behave inappropriately will receive appropriate consequences in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct.

# Meeting Expectations





### **SCREEN ON/MIC OFF**

This helps the presenter know you are engaged and involved in the meeting. If you need to leave the meeting momentarily, it is okay to turn your screen off, but make sure to turn it back on.

Your microphone should be off unless you are speaking, or if the presenter requests otherwise. This will help to prevent feedback during meetings.



### **BE ON TIME**

Be on time and ready to begin at the start of each meeting. This includes breaks and lunch. Be respectful of the presenter and other attendees.



### NO DISTRACTIONS

Make sure you are in a room without distractions. Family members, pets, and even your phone can distract you.

Also, make sure to remove anything from your screen or background that could be a distraction.



### **QUESTIONS**

If you have questions, place them in the chat unless the presenter requests otherwise.



### CONFIDENTIAL INFO

Meetings should not be recorded if confidential information is being shared. Recording of such meetings could lead to a FERPA violation if those recordings are shared.

The meeting cannot take place in the presence of family members or household guests. This includes recorded or non-recorded meetings. The presence of family members or household guests is a FERPA violation, as these individuals will have access to student information.



### **URGENT MATTERS**

If you need to leave the meeting momentarily to address an urgent matter, notify the group and turn off your camera, returning as soon as possible.
