# AD Owens Report: Grade School

#### Wrestling

The Dwight Wrestling Team had five wrestlers qualify to compete in the Sectionals at Peoria. 6<sup>th</sup> grader Aidan Scholwin and 8<sup>th</sup> graders, Malaki Slaughter, Dillon Sarff, Emmett Emmons, and Sam Edwards, represented the Redbirds at Sectionals on Saturday, March 3<sup>rd</sup>. With great performances, four of our wrestlers (Slaughter, Sarff, Emmons, and Edwards) advanced to the State Tournament at NIU, which will be held on Friday, March 9<sup>th</sup>, and Saturday, March 10<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Volleyball**

The 7<sup>th</sup> grade girls' volleyball season completed their season a few weeks ago. On Monday, February 26<sup>th</sup>, the ladies competed as the fifth seed in the first round of the IESA Regionals at Gardner. The 7<sup>th</sup> graders played hard but fell in two close games to Rockford Barbour. The ladies ended their season with a record of 5-12.
