Wrestling

The Dwight Wrestling Team had five wrestlers qualify to compete in the Sectionals at Peoria. 6th grader Aidan Scholwin and 8th graders, Malaki Slaughter, Dillon Sarff, Emmett Emmons, and Sam Edwards, represented the Redbirds at Sectionals on Saturday, March 3rd. With great performances, four of our wrestlers (Slaughter, Sarff, Emmons, and Edwards) advanced to the State Tournament at NIU, which will be held on Friday, March 9th, and Saturday, March 10th.

Volleyball

The 7th grade girls' volleyball season completed their season a few weeks ago. On Monday, February 26th, the ladies competed as the fifth seed in the first round of the IESA Regionals at Gardner. The 7th graders played hard but fell in two close games to Rockford Barbour. The ladies ended their season with a record of 5-12. The 8th grade team is currently 9-8. After a 1-4 regular season record in the IVC Conference, the girls placed third in the IVC Tournament with a defeat over MVK. The girls open up regionals at Seneca on Tuesday, March 6, against Putnam County.
