

New COVID Procedures and Guidelines

**\*All calls/questions regarding illness of students and staff should be immediately directed to the nurse's office.**

1. Student or Staff experiencing symptoms	To be determined	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must test at school or somewhere else and show documentation.</li> <li>• If student is exhibiting symptoms or communicating symptoms in classroom, student should be sent to nurse's office and <b>the Nurse will make the decision whether or not to test.</b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If negative, individual can return to school as long as fever free for 24 hours</li> <li>• Any student or staff member that had tested positive for Covid-19 in the last 90 days do not need to be tested or excluded due to Covid.</li> <li>• Student that refuses testing will be excluded from school for 5 days from symptom onset.</li> </ul>
2. Student or Staff tests positive and never develops symptoms (asymptomatic)	Isolate for Full 5 Days	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Continue to wear a well-fitting mask around others until day 10 (day 6-10)</li> <li>• If at all possible, isolate from others in the home.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Day 0 is the day of positive test or when the symptoms first started</li> <li>• If the individual develops symptoms after testing positive, the 5-day isolation timeline starts over</li> </ul>
3. Students or staff who have COVID-19 and have or had symptoms (fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication and other symptoms have improved after 5 days)	Can end isolation after 5 full days if they are fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication and other symptoms have improved	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Continue to wear a well-fitting mask around others until day 10 (day 6-10)</li> <li>• If at all possible, isolate from others in the home.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Day 0 is the day of positive test or when the symptoms first started</li> <li>• <b>Day of the start of symptoms and symptom improvement must be determined in consultation with the nurse.</b></li> </ul>

4. Close Contact to Positive COVID-19 Individual at or away from a school setting. Individual is vaccinated.	No Isolation Required if agree to Test to Stay	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wear Mask around others for 10 days</li> <li>Test on Day 3 and Day 6</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If at all possible, isolate from others in the home.</li> <li>If a person develops symptoms, they should immediately isolate until a negative test confirms symptoms are not caused by COVID-19</li> </ul>
5. Close Contact to Positive COVID-19 Individual in a School Setting. Individual is not vaccinated	No Isolation Required if agree to Test to Stay	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wear Mask around others for 10 days</li> <li>Test on Day 2 and Day 5</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If at all possible, isolate from others in the home.</li> <li>If a person develops symptoms, they should immediately isolate until a negative test confirms symptoms are not caused by COVID-19</li> </ul>
6. Close Contact to Positive COVID-19 Individual in an Out of School Setting. Individual is not vaccinated	Stay home and mask around others for five (5) days.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Continue to wear mask around others days 6-10.</li> <li>Test on Day 5, if negative can return</li> <li>If a person develops symptoms, they should immediately isolate until a negative test confirms symptoms are not caused by COVID-19</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If at all possible, isolate positive individual from others in the home.</li> </ul>
