## AGENDA ITEM 21-23 CATEC — "Year in Review"

Mrs. Carter highlighted the positive things that happened at CATEC this year despite the challenges. She went into detail about the partnership with Cultivate Charlottesville and Siller Pollinator Company. There continued to be a focus on work-based learning and there were several successful Food Bus events. Mrs. Carter also explained Career Declaration Day, the Signing Event, Interview Week, and the plans for the Completers' Ceremony. She stated that there has been a lot of traction in the partnership with the CATEC Foundation Board as well as Red Wing Shoes and Diamondback Tools. One of CATEC's goals is that every

student will be as prepared as possible when they leave with the resources they need to transition into their new jobs. There has been success with inter-disciplinary instruction with English and Cosmetology, Biology and Vet Science, and the bee house project in Building Trades.

Mrs. Carter reported that enrollment was 290 at the 10-day count last fall and she is anticipating a projected enrollment of 289 for the upcoming year. Scheduling has been delayed, so she hopes that enrollment will increase. Mrs. Carter reviewed the student demographics. A concentration on embedded instruction in Building Trades and Electricity as well as Culinary Arts will continue. Attention will be paid to recruitment to highlight all that CATEC has to offer in order to increase enrollment and make it available to any student who wants to be here. CATEC will partner with Morven Farm and the PB&J Fund to expand farm-to-table cooking. She hopes to upgrade the Auto Body lab and utilize another lab area for Emergency Services. In response to Dr. Acuff's question about the Foundation Board's role, Mrs. Carter explained that the Foundation's vision is to raise money so that the facilities can be updated, provide scholarships to CATEC students, and be an advocate for CATEC to expand local business connections. Ms. Callsen requested, when being given the student demographics in future meetings, that Mrs. Carter also provide a base level for comparison.
