Brandy said she would work concessions for the volleyball regional game, which is Tuesday, Oct. 18.


Brandy motioned to adjourn and Deb seconded.

Fall 2016-2017, Twin Cedars Elementary (6512-0418), by Grade



Seven students will be attending Character Counts. Twin Cedars will be hosting a volleyball regional game on October 18th at 7:00. Mr. Roby will be attending a Teach Iowa training in West Des Moines and a Legal Lab in November. The Bluegrass Conference Vocal concert will be on October 31st. Ms. McNally wrote and received a \$500 energy grant. She would like to use it to purchase wind turbine kits for the classroom.

Mr. VanderSluis had bids for the parking lot project. After reviewing the bids it looks like maybe there is something wrong as the asphalt and concrete numbers are exactly the same. Mr. VanderSluis will check into this and get the correct numbers. This is still being planned for the Summer of 2017. We will go out for bids in January. Mr. VanderSluis said the new scoreboard has been installed at the football field. The baseball and softball scoreboards will be installed later. The softball board will be relocated closer to centerfield. The fence at the softball field needs replaced. The backstop is leaning. He shared some bids on this. Mr. VanderSluis also shared that the district needs to look at purchasing a pickup for pushing snow, etc. He looks at the cost for one with the state bid, single cab, 4WD, 8ft bed. The board thought this would be the best plan since the current pickup that is used is 30 years old. Mr. VanderSluis also handed out a tentative student count. As of today, Twin Cedars is up 14 students from a year ago.

Mr. VanderSluis covered the new business of the parking lot in his reporting. There was no other new business to be discussed.
